4. REGISTRATION AND MEANS OF PAYMENT

7. BIBS AND HELMETS

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets during official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A penalty will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 10€ per bib. The deposit will be refunded at the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

8. LIABILITY

All competitors, officials and other members of their National Association who attend or participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee: Val Thorens, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by competitors, officials or other persons in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

9. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee: Val Thorens ski resort, the FIS and the French Ski Association will not be held responsible for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

10. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.
