RULES

Megeve is organizing an international competition, the 2012 FIS Freestyle Dual Moguls World Cup Final.

This competition, for both men and women, will be held under the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup rules (Art 12).

According to the FIS international calendar, the competition will take place on March 18th 2012 following the official program.

The Organizing Committee, in consultation with the FIS, reserves the right to modify the schedule and the place of the event stated in the program, depending on the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.

FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Final Eligibility Formula and Final Format (Rule 12) with limited fields.

This competition is by invitation only (WC 12.4 page 14) The fields are limited to the following maximum numbers:

Ladies/Men: 24/24 +COC Winners+ WJC Winners competitors

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in the respective valid FIS point list.

The minimum FIS point requirements for FIS Freestyle Dual Mogul World Cup events are 50 Mogul FIS points. One competitor per gender can be entered that has between 25-50 Moguls FIS points.

The Organizer needs to check on this as soon as they receive the entries.

ACCREDITATION:

All officials and competitors will receive an accreditation card from the Organizing Committee providing free access to the competition site. The card must be worn all the time.

BIBS:

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official training and competition.

ACCIDENT / INSURANCE :

All competitors must have their own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee declines all liability for any accident or equipment damaged during trainings and competition

ACCOMMODATION :

Teams will be lodged in hotel with half board, from **Thursday night March 15th to Monday morning march 19th, 2012** .

Lunch will be organized by the organizing committee (friday, saturday, sunday) in the tent at the bottom of the mogul course. If you don't want it, thank you to tell us before, if not this will be invoiced.

Each coach has to pay his team accommodation expenses directly to the organizing committee the day of his arrival (Thursday 15th). No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the racers.

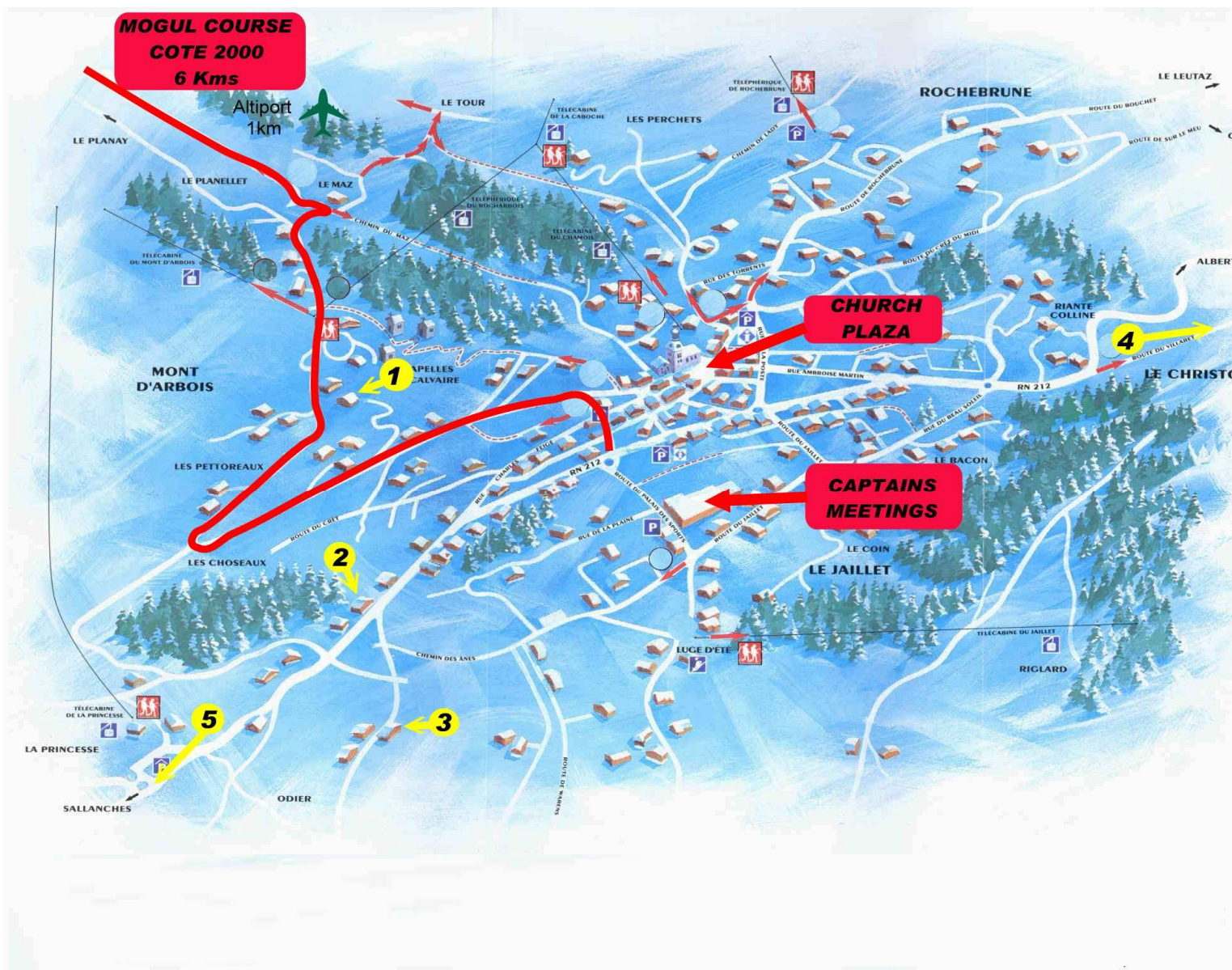

ORGANIZING CENTER :

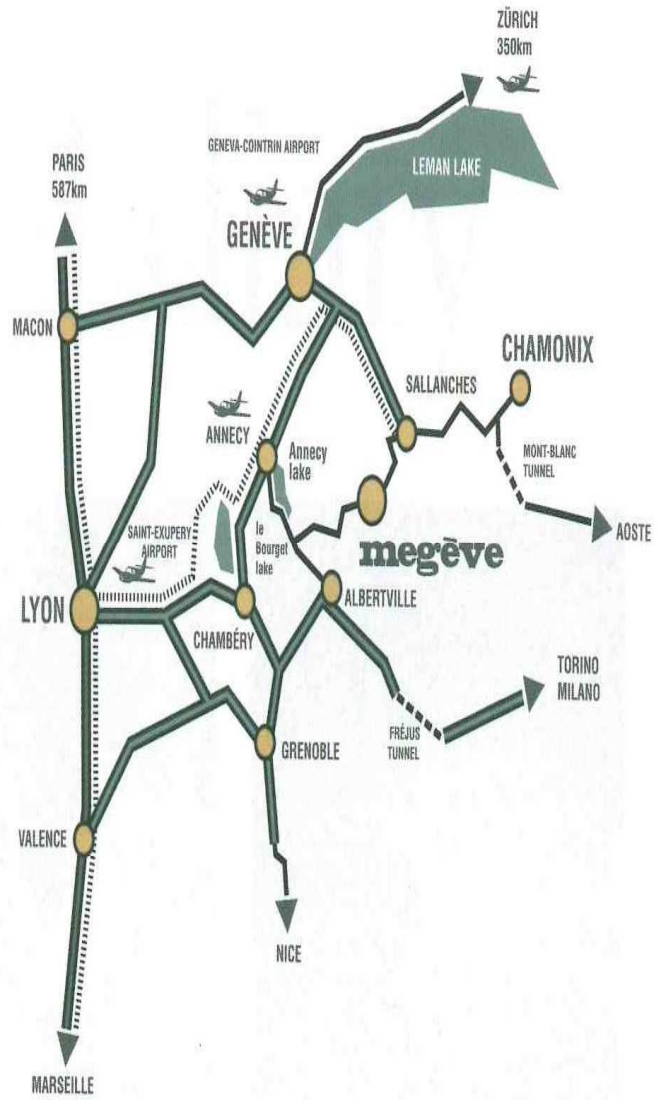
The Organizing Center is located in the Palais des sports de Megève
