### NOTES

#### How point scores are calculated

A competitor is awarded 60 points for jumping the K-point distance. For every meter more or less than the K-point, a competitor has 2.4 points added or subtracted from his total. In addition, competitors are awarded points for style (for flight, landing and out-run) up to a maximum of 20 per judge. Five judges score each jump, with the highest and lowest scores discarded and the scores of the other three summed and added to the competitor's points for distance.
