Competition Rules

The number of participants in the competitions must comply with official FIS competition rules and regulations.

Insurance

All athletes have to be insured by their own National Ski Associations. The Organiser has coverage for their own third part liability only. All attendants have to be covered by an adequate insurance policy against accidents, illness and civil liability.

Doping Control

Doping control may be carried out at any FIS competition according to FIS Anti-Doping Rules.

Economy

Financial conditions are according to the FIS rules and regulations. The Organising Committee will pay for the accommodation costs according to the FIS competition rules and the FIS Ski Jumping Nation's quota.

PLEASE NOTE: The prize money and travel money will only be paid to bank accounts.

Waxing Facilities

The waxing area is located close to the Ski Jumping Hill and Cross Country Arena, according to FIS rules.

Training facilities

Ski jumping training in Lysgårdsbakken; If the snow and weather conditions do not allow free training, the organiser will have to close the hill from Tuesday morning 29 November 2011.

Gym training and volleyball fields will be available for the Teams in Haakon Hall.

Transportation

The Teams will be transported from Oslo International Airport Gardermoen to the hotels in Lillehammer and return after the World Cup (Sunday 4 or Monday 5 December). Shuttle transport will be available from the hotels to the competition areas. Please fill in the enclosed transport form.
