## General information

The Organizing Committee will host the 2012 Snowboard Junior World Championships in accordance with the International Snowboard Competition Rules (ICR) of the International Ski Federation (FIS) and Rules for the Organization of FIS Snowboard Junior World Championships.

## Age limits

The classes entitled to participate to the FIS Junior Snowboard World Championships are as follow:

- ▶ PGS, PSL, SBX: 1992 to 1996.
- ▶ HP, SBS: 1992 to 1998.

## Quotas

Exact maximum Quotas per National Ski Association and maximum Team size and maximum Quota per gender will be confirmed by FIS in Fall 2012.

## Ceremonies

The Opening Ceremony will be held in Sierra Nevada at the Andalucía Square on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> March at 5:00 p.m. A winner's presentation will be held immediately after every competition at the Finish Area. The Awards Ceremony will be held every racing day at the Finish Area or the Andalucía Square.

## Race Office & Team Captains meetings

The race Office will be located at the Sierra Nevada High Performance Training Center. The Team Captains meetings will be held at the same place. Usual time for meetings is 6:00 p.m.

## Bibs

Athletes must wear the official bib during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. The training and competition bibs will be usually distributed at the Team Captains meetings. A bib deposit of 25€ per bib will be required.

## Radio permits

Teams are asked to inform the OC about their radio frequencies so as to be able to get the radio permits for them, according to Spanish rules. The information should be sent by e-mail to the Organizing Committee by 22nd January 2011. No radio permits can be guaranteed without this request.

## Accident insurance

Each competitor must have her/his own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee of Sierra Nevada as well as the sponsors, suppliers, their agents and the FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event. All athletes must have previously signed the "FIS Athletes Declaration" form in order to register.

## Doping control

Doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

## Transportation

Sierra Nevada is located in southern Spain, the closest airports to Sierra Nevada are Granada and Malaga. Teams are responsible for their own transportation to and from Sierra Nevada. The Organizing Committee can help the teams to find transportation to Sierra Nevada from those airports. Inside village transportation and lift tickets will be provided by the OC.

## Accommodation

For the competitors and officials inside the FIS quota fixed on the rules, the price for accommodation in double room and half board will be 48.42€ (CHF 60) and 80.07€ (CHF 100) for the accompanying persons out of this quota. Accommodation will be only available at the FIS rate for the dates of the program, from 22nd March to 1st April 2012. Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not subject to the FIS rate. Single room & half board will be provided at the price of 100€.

So as to secure the booking, payment is required before the arrival of the team. "No Shows" will be charged to the National Associations. Teams will be held responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. Extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves.
