The Organizing Committee will host the SBX FIS Ladies-Men Snowboard in accordance with the International Snowboard Competition Rules (ICR) of the International Ski Federation (FIS).

Right of Participation

Only competitors with active FIS code for season 2011/2012 and regarding the current FIS races quota regulations will be accepted.

The Race program will be confirmed by the Organizing Committee in Team Captains meeting

Race Office & Team Captains meetings

The race Office will be located at the XALET ECOA, situated in C/ de l'Anglada s/n - AD300 ORDINO. The team captains meeting will be held at the same place on Saturday 17^{th} .

Bibs and Helmets

Athletes must wear the official bib and homologated helmet during all official training and competition. The official bib must wear too in award ceremonies. The competition bibs will be distributed at the Team Captains meeting.

Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have her/his own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee of SBX FIS Ladies-Men as well the sponsors, suppliers, their agents and the FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or loss of equipment and second and third party claims during the event. All athletes must have previously signed the "FIS Athletes Declaration" form in order to register.











Doping Control

Doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.
