

#### **ENTRY FEE**

\$77.00 per Race. Credit card facilities available at the TCM. Cash is also acceptable.

#### **BIB DEPOSIT**

A security deposit of \$50.00 per bib or \$200.00 per team is payable to the Mt Buller Race Club at the Team Captains meeting before issue of bibs. Deposit will be returned on return of bibs after completion of racing.

#### LIFT TICKETS

For competition days, discounted lift tickets (supported by Buller Ski Lifts Ltd.) for competitors can be ordered in advance for \$59.00 (Payable by cash or Credit Card). Per 5 competitors one FOC coach ticket will be issued. The top 10 FIS points holders also receive free lift passes during competition days. For lift tickets please fill out the form on page 6. #### TOM MATHIAS MEMORIAL AWARD



Tom Mathias started training with the club in 1998 and continued on to have an illustrious career in the sport. He reached an elite level and was a member of the Australian National Ski Team. He was an extremely valued member of the club and as well as competing was an extremely bright young man studying at The University of Melbourne.

Tom had a long battle with his illness (melanoma cancer) and he approached it with the same guts and determination he had learned to use in his training and racing career.

Mt Buller Race Club is holding these slalom races in memoriam of Tom, who passed away at the young age of 23. The "Tom Mathias Memorial Award" will be awarded to the male competitor with the fastest combined time of both races (4 runs total).

#### **INFORMATION – GETTING TO MT BULLER**

Mt Buller is only a short 3-hour drive from Melbourne via the Hume Highway or Maroondah Highway, and the scenery on the way is well worth taking your time to see and enjoy.

No matter which route you take from Melbourne to Mt Buller you will eventually come to Mansfield - the closest major town to the Resort. Pass through Mansfield and follow the signs to Mt Buller.

At the base of Mt Buller (Mirimbah) you will be required to stop at the gate entry point and pay a fee to enter the Resort. Once through the gate entry point, continue up a well-maintained road to Mt Buller.

As the Mt Buller Village is located above the snow line, only a limited amount and type of cars are permitted to drive into the Village (access during winter is restricted to residents, property owners and mountain staff). Most cars are required to stop at a car park located approximately 1.5km below the Village. At this point, you will be met by an attendant who will guide you to a parking spot.

From here, you can either jump on a free shuttle bus (for day visitors) that will take you up into the Village centre or take a 4WD taxi (for people staying overnight) which will take you to your accommodation. Once you're in the Village, there is a free Intra-Village Shuttle Service that features three different routes to get you around the Village during your stay.

NOTE: Please inform the ROC if you are traveling to the mountain on a daily basis as shuttle buses and taxis do not operate early in the morning.

#### Wheel chains - day visitors

Mt Buller's wheel chain requirements are decided on a daily basis and are determined by weather forecasts and existing road conditions. Chain requirements may vary between 2-Wheel Drive (2WD) and 4-Wheel Drive (4WD) and All-Wheel Drive (AWD) vehicles, as each of these types of cars react differently to snow and icy road conditions.

Daily wheel chain requirements are communicated via the local accommodation providers, retail outlets and authorities who come into contact with people travelling to the Resort. They also appear on large flashing roadside billboards as you enter and leave Mansfield and on the daily snow report. Contact Resort Management directly on (03) 5777 6077 for the most current requirements.

#### Wheel chains - overnight stays

If you are staying in the Resort overnight or traveling beyond the Skating Rink car park area and past the snowline, you are required to carry chains at all times as weather conditions can change unexpectedly throughout the evening.


