The team package will include:

- Three buffet meals daily at the hotel or nearby; the hours of service will recognize race schedules.
- Bagged lunches will be available from the hotels by request the night before needed.
- Teams may make additional meal requests with the hotel at their own costs.

The Accommodation details must be completed on the FIS Online system by October 31<sup>st</sup> 2012. For Room cancellation the FIS World Cup Rule 13.1 applies.

#### **4. Transport (World Cup Rules Art. 11)**

The Organising Committee will provide one arrival/departure transfer from the Calgary International Airport per team according to FIS regulations.

- Please use the FIS online system to indicate your team travel arrangements. If you are renting a vehicle, please indicate this so your team may be given a parking pass from the Race Office.
- Price for additional transport:
  - Approx \$55.00 per person CDN from Calgary airport
- Information to the Shuttle service  
A shuttle service will be provided between the official accommodations and the venue. Further details on the timelines will be communicated upon arrival

#### **5. Payment (World Cup Rules Art. 10 and 13)**

- Accommodation costs: Teams will make arrangements for hotel deposit and final payments directly with the hotel, with the exception of the Red Group athletes for which hotel costs will be paid directly by the OC prior to the final race.
- Carrying costs/Reimbursement:
  - Payment on Saturday 2012/12/15 in financial office (Bill Warren Training Centre) at 18:00
  - All payments will be done by bank transfer to National Ski Association

#### **6. Waxing facilities (World Cup Rules Art. 14)**

- Wax cabins: available from 2012/12/09 at 08:00
- Keys may be picked up at the Team Compound Office, with a \$40 deposit. Wax rooms are supplied with North American standard 120v electricity. Please bring compatible equipment; you will also need this for Quebec.

#### **7. Regulations of radio equipment**

If you are bringing radio equipment, the Canadian Government may require on-site radio inspection in order to confirm use of approved radio frequencies.

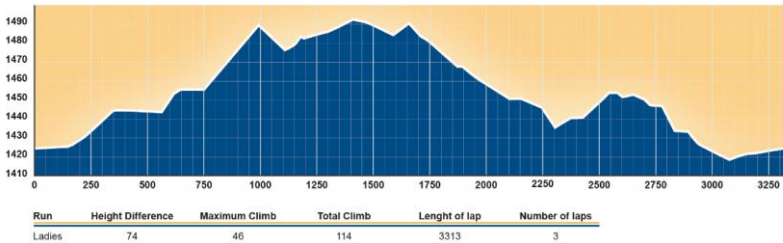
#### **9. Ski pass**

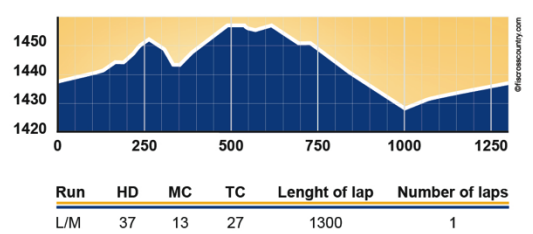

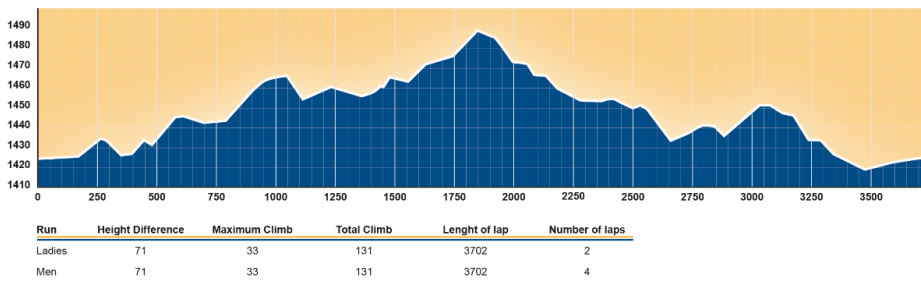
Canmore, Olympic course, 3,3 km
