4. Transport (World Cup Rules Art. 11)

- Official airport: Helsinki airport (94 km from Lahti)
The organising committee will arrange transportation between the airport and hotels /ski service area. One transport free of charge. Price for additional transport: 100 €

5. Payment (World Cup Rules Art. 10 and 13)

- Accommodation costs: Teams will pay directly in their hotels if not agreed otherwise (persons from the pay lists will be paid by the OC directly).
- Carrying costs/reimbursement:
 - Payment on Friday 08/03/2013 in Financial office (main building at ski stadium 3rd floor) at 18:00
 - All payment will be done by bank transfer

6. Waxing facilities (World Cup Rules Art. 14)

- Wax cabins: available from 04/03/2013 at 08:00
- Waxing trucks: teams arriving with trucks have to inform the OC before 06/10/2012

7. Regulations of radio equipment

- Radio equipment can only be used with permission of the Finnish Communications Regulatory Authority (FICORA). All radio equipment and frequencies must be inspected in Lahti. Teams are responsible for their own inspections at competition office (field level of Ski Stadium building) on Thu 07/03 – Fri 08/03
