### 3. Accommodation (World Cup Rules Art. 13)

- Booking according to the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system
- Your accommodation requests (team size) should be done through the FIS Online Registration System before **until 30<sup>th</sup> September** (first come, first serve principal). The final size of the team and number of rooms must be given before December 19<sup>th</sup>. For room cancellation after December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2012, the FIS World Cup Rules point 13.2 applies. This means that the respective National Ski Association has to pay the difference between effective and reserved rooms (tolerance 10%).
- Teams wishing to take care of their own accommodation arrangements are welcome to do so but will take over full responsibility for all details and cannot expect receiving the above-mentioned rates.

### 4. Transport (World Cup Rules Art. 11)

- For Stage-to-Stage transportation, the teams must have their own vehicles and are independent. There will be no transportation organised by the Organising Committees from venue to venue. The teams have right for one free transport from the first airport (before the first stage from Frankfurt to Oberhof) and to the final airport (after the last stage). For Oberhof please contact Christopher Gellert ([info@weltcup-oberhof.de](mailto:info@weltcup-oberhof.de) or +49 36842 5220). **Teams travelling with trucks will need a special permission to be able to drive in Germany on Sunday.**

### 5. Payment (World Cup Rules Art. 10 and 13)

- Financial conditions apply as stated in the FIS World Cup Rules. The teams are requested to pay all their hotel expenses for all team members - including Red Group athletes and eligible coaches directly at the hotel
- The organisers pay for **the travel and living costs** (accommodation, food etc.) according to the conditions mentioned in the World Cup rules.

Travel costs will be paid once and by bank transfer by the organisers to the teams at the last resort. The **Red Group List and their qualified coaches get free accommodation**, for at least two nights before the first FIS TOUR DE SKI competition until at least the morning after the last FIS TOUR DE SKI competition.

## 6. Waxing facilities

- Wax cabins: available from 26/12/2012 at 08:00
- Waxing trucks: teams arriving with trucks have to inform the OC before 06/10/2012

## 7. Regulations of radio equipment

- Use of radio transmission equipment in Germany and Italy is regulated by national law. Permits for the use of radio transmission equipment must be requested according to national specifications.
