Accreditation

Accreditations will be available in the Race Office in Ushuaia upon arrival.

Competition Rules

The competitions will be held in compliance with FIS International Competition Rules and Continental Cup Rules.

Insurance

All the athletes must be insured through their National Ski Associations. The organizer is not responsible for any injury to person or damage to property. All participants and team staff must be covered by an adequate insurance policy against accidents, illness and civil liability.

Team Captains Meetings

The team captains will receive all necessary information on arrival in Ushuaia. Information concerning weather reports, social events, program etc., will be given regularly at the Team Captains Meetings and also in writing in the race office. The meetings will take place in a meeting room (TBA) in one of our host hotels and will be included in your arrival information.

Transportation

What airport is the best for international arrival?

Most international flights arrive in Buenos Aires at the Ministro Pistarini International Airport (EZE).

Do we need to book domestic flights?

International flights arrive into two Airports in Argentina. Ezeiza (EZE), Ministro Pistarini is the International Airport in Buenos Aires however it is also possible to fly into the domestic airport, Jorge Newberry Airport – Aeroparque (AEP) from abroad. Flying into AEP eliminates the need for a 1 to 1 1/2 hour transfer from EZE to AEP. Most of the Domestic flights from Buenos Aires to Ushuaia (USH) leave from AEP. It is possible also to connect to USH thru EZE but flights are more limited. We would suggest checking with your travel agents for the best prices/connections into Ushuaia from your originating country.

Transfers from Ushuaia Airport, to and from the hotels in Ushuaia are free of charge for the participating teams. Teams must arrange this directly with Diego Linares prior to arrival: email: diego.linares@hotmail.com • +54 9 2901 54 7484.





Accommodation

Teams must book their own accommodations. Hotel Albatros Group, Ushuaia is the official team hotel group for the event. The price is US\$ 95 per person/per night with half board based on double occupancy and in compliance with quotas and official NSA team entries.

Payment Policy

50% of the team accommodations must be paid by: <u>July 16</u>
After July 16th, the team reservation will be adjusted on the number of 50% deposits received.

50% remaining balance is due by: <u>July 30</u> After July 30th, the team reservation will be adjusted to the number of paid in full accommodations.

Cancellation Policy

Any booking cancellation beyond its deadline will result in charges as detailed:

- -Cancellations received before 16-July will have no charge.
- -Cancellations received between 16-July and 30-July will be charged for 50% of the charged cancelled booking.
- -Cancellations received after 30-July will be charged for the total amount of the cancelled booking.
- -NO-SHOW Bookings: Will be charged with the total cost of the rooms booked.

For teams who would like to upgrade for more single rooms than the rules require, the official hotel price applies (not the team price of max US 55 per night per person based on double occupancy).

For teams/staff outside the quota, and for all athletes/officials before and after the official World Cup period, the rates will be at the discretion of the Hotel Albatros Group.

All guests are requested to pay their personal expenses directly to the hotel when checking out.
