### **2. Rules**

- The French freestyle Association and La Rosière Committee are organising international competitions part of the 2012/2013 FIS Freestyle Europa Cup Circuit :
  - 1 Europa Cup Moguls single
  - 1 Europa Cup Moguls Dual
- These competitions will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- These competitions are open both men and women
- These competitions will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather or the decision of the competition jury

### 3. Entries

Entries will be accepted from the National ski Associations in accordance with the FIS qualification quotas and rules for the Freestyle Europa Cup.

### 4. Registration and means of payment

**Race Office: Salle Arpin in “Maison du Ski”**

Team registration will take place beginning on:

- Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> at the “**Race Office**” from 14:00 to 18:00

All fees and deposits must be paid in CHF or EUR and be paid in cash.

**No cheques, no CB. Only travellers cheques will be accepted.**

**Price 50 CHF or 42 € / per person per event.**

### 5. Accommodation

Teams are free to book their accommodation.

But the event take place in busy period, we recommend all the teams to check their accommodation with the organizing committee as soon as possible

We have a special price for the Europa cup event in **Auberge du Val Joli** for this period : Saturday the 09<sup>th</sup> of February until Wednesday the 13<sup>th</sup> of February 2013 (4 nights)

- many classic rooms for 2, 4, 5, and 6 people with single and bunk beds
- 2 “refuge rooms” for 2 and 6 people with single and bunk beds
- 3 “familiale suites” for 6 to 12 people with single and bunk beds

Price Half board included = between 55 € and 70€ /per pers and by night

The team Captains meeting will be held in “Salle Arpin de la Maison du Ski”

## **7. Bibs and Helmets**

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets during official training, competitions and award ceremony ( bib only). A penalty will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. A deposit (10 € perbib) will be asked at each team leader. These deposits will be refunded at the end of the competitions after bibs returned.

## **8. Liability**

All competitors, officials and other members of their National Association who attend or participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee La Rosière, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by competitors, officials or other persons in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

## **9. Accident Insurance**

Every competitor must be individually medically insured . The Organizing Committee, La Rosière, the FIS and the French Ski Association will not be held responsible for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

## **10. Accident Protocol**

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.
