GENERAL INFORMATION

Accreditation

Accreditations will be available in the Service Centre at Holmenkollen Park Hotel Rica adjacent to the venue.

For any changes of more than 10% made after 4 March, the National Ski Association in question is obliged to pay the difference between the effective and announced persons. Rooms reserved but not used have to be paid (100%) by the National Ski Association in question.

Accommodation costs:

The teams will pay for the accommodation in the reimbursement/financial office at Holmenkollen Park Hotel. The rooms used by persons from the pay lists will be paid by the OC directly. Teams (team captains) will pay directly to the hotels for all extras (room service, movies, from bar, etc).

Carrying costs/Reimbursement:

The Financial Office is located close to the Service Center and will be open from Thursday-Sunday 08.00-20.00. Prize money will be sent directly to the athlete after signature has been received (in person at the financial office). All payment will be done by bank wire transfer.

Please remind the athletes to bring their account number and IBAN/SWIFT code.

Competiton Rules

The competitions will be held in compliance with FIS International Competition Rules and World Cup Rules.

Doping Control

Anti-doping testing may take place during the event according to FIS rules.

Entries by FIS Online Entry System

Access to the FIS online entry system is through the FIS Online Update (FOU) System which is accessed via the Member Section on the FIS website www.fis-ski.com.

Insurance

All the athletes have to be insured through their National Ski Associations. The organiser is not responsible for any injury to person or damage to property. All participants and team staff must be covered by an adequate insurance policy against accidents, illness and civil liability.

Ski testing and waxing

Nordic Combined: Ski testing area and waxing area will be close to the stadium. The wax cabins for cross country will be available from Sunday 10 March. Ski jumping cabins will be available from Wednesday 13 March.

Note: Holmenkollbakken will not be open for training Monday-Wednesday (11-13 March) before the Official Training on Thursday 14 March. However, it will be possible to jump in Midstubakken (HS 106) if the weather conditions are acceptable.

Ski Jumping: The wax cabins will be available from 7:00 a.m on Saturday 16 March. Please send an e-mail to team@holmenkollen.com if your team needs the cabin earlier, and we will make sure that the key is available for you in the reception at Holmenkollen Park Hotel.

Sports Service/Attaché Service

There will be an information desk for the teams in the Service Centre at Holmenkollen Park Hotel Rica adjacent to the venue.

Each nation will have an attaché assigned to them during the World Cup to support the teams with arrivals and departures and to provide administrative and linguistic support. Each Team Manager will determine the specific responsibilities and duties of the attaché.

Team Captains Meetings

The team captains will get all necessary information on arrival in Holmenkollen. Information concerning weather reports, social events, program etc., will be given regularly at the Team Captains Meetings and also in writing.
