1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. All entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS Homepage: <http://www.fis-ski.com/> "Member Section". Entries by mail or fax are no longer accepted.

2. REGISTRATION

The registration will take place starting on Wednesday, January 30th, from 07:30 - 19:00. Prior to hotel check-in, teams are required to go directly to the Race Office located in the Grand Central Base Lodge (http://conferences.bluemountain.ca/grand_central_lodge.htm). Race Office hours will be from 07:30 to 19:00 from Wednesday, January 30 to Saturday, February 2.

All fees must be paid upon registration by a designated team representative.

- Please note Free-Riding will be available on Wednesday, January 30. Tickets can be picked up at Registration.

2. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for participation in the FIS Snowboard World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have a valid FIS Code. All fees and deposits must be paid in cash or credit card upon registration.



3. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation and meal services will be at either the Cranberry Resort (<http://www.thecranberryresort.com/>), or the Blue Mountain Inn (http://www.bluemountain.ca/lodging_blue_inn_1.htm) from Wednesday night January 30 to Sunday morning February 3rd 2013 (4 nights at the FIS rate, 50 CHF). Teams will be advised of their hotel accommodation upon registration at the Race Office.

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, all competitors and team officials will pay the Organizing Committee the Cdn dollar (in cash or credit card) equivalent of 50 Swiss Francs per day. Each coach has to pay his/her team accommodation expenses on arrival day. No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

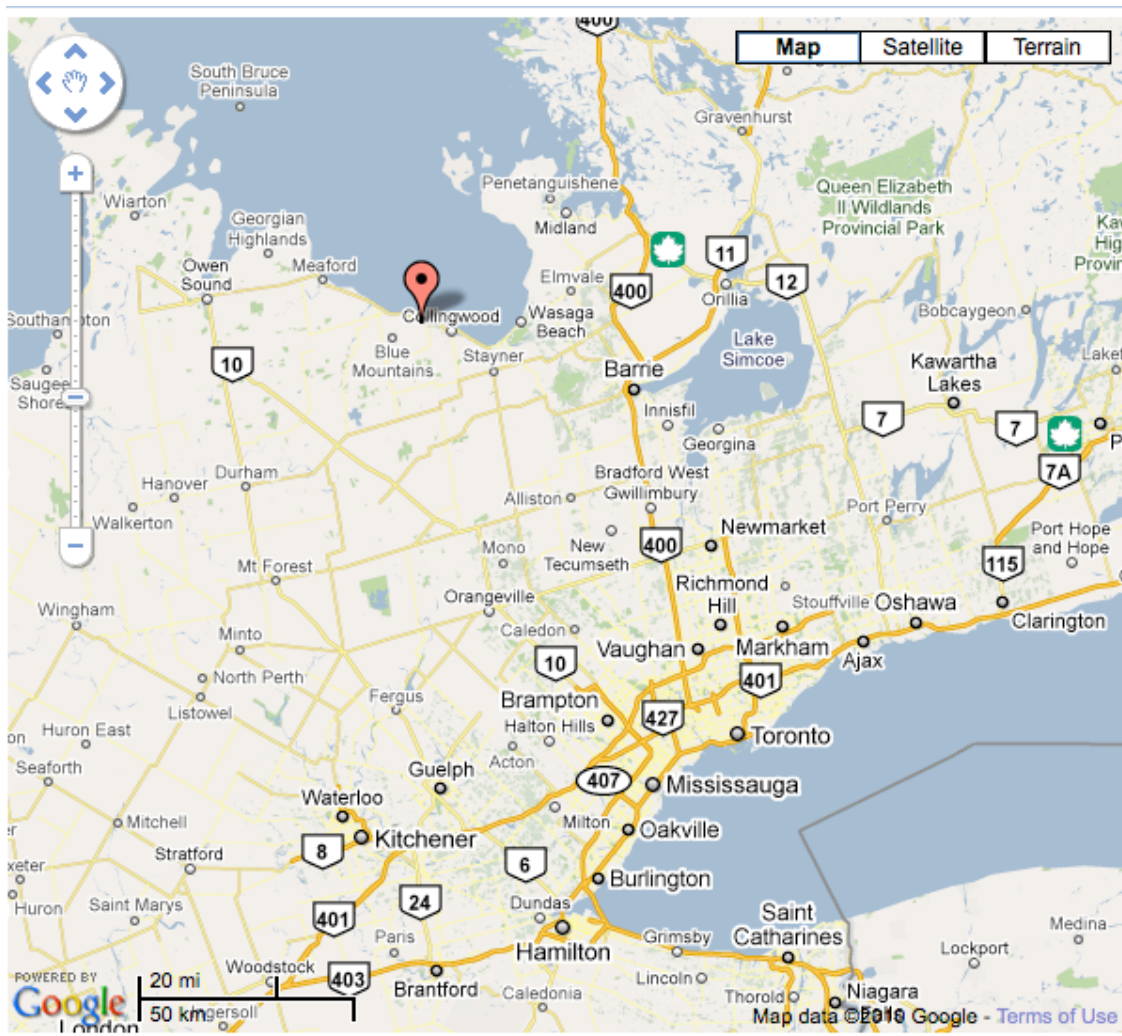
Single room(s) per team will be provided according to the table outlined in the Snowboard World Cup rules. It is the responsibility of the team to determine who receives the room(s). Any additional single rooms beyond quota requested will be provided only if available and at market rate.

Market rate for additional single rooms or early arrival is \$125.00/night Canadian.

These conditions will be applied to anyone registered through the online entry system, which must be submitted to the Organizing Committee by January 24th, 2013.

4. TRANSPORTATION

Transportation from the Toronto airport to Blue Mountain located 7km west of Collingwood, Ontario, is the responsibility of the individual teams. The drive is approximately 2 hours, and directions can be found at: http://www.bluemountain.ca/directions/toronto_airport.html





5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

February 2: Saturday - World Cup Competition Day

8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision to local hospital in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

9. MEDICAL AND DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
