

Please submit the preliminary Entry - the anticipated number of your competitors, including officials - by January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

The final Entry with the number (competitors and officials) and the name of participants must be submitted to the organizing committee **no later than January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013.**

### **ACCOMMODATION:**

The athletes and team captains will be guests of the organizing committee (nights of January 25<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup>) in a specific hotel in Covilhã.

Each athlete will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Meals will be provided.

For the rest of the staff and accompanying people the organization may help booking hotel reservations. Note that in these cases the prices are responsibility of the hotel. Organizing committee can also provide hotels information.

### **TRANSPORTATION:**

Covilhã is located in the southeast of Serra da Estrela, Castelo Branco, Portugal. The nearest airports are Lisbon and Oporto.

Free transfer from the airports to the hotel in Covilhã and back (3 hours approx. one way) will be arranged.

Covilhã is also easy to get to by public transport with nice railway and bus services. Organization can help with public transport timetables from and to the airports.





#### **BIBS**:

All competitors must wear the official bib during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. The training and competition bibs will be distributed at the Team Captains Meeting.

#### **ACCIDENT INSURANCE:**

Each competitor must have her/his own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee as well the sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the town of Covilhã and FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or loss of equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

All athletes must have previously signed the "FIS Athletes Declaration" form in order to register.

MEDICAL AND DOPING: Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.

# **PRIZE MONEY:**

Prize money fund is 6000€ and will be paid in cash in accordance with the Continental Cup Rules 2012/2013 after the finish of the event.

The Portuguese State Tax will be deducted from the prize money in accordance with the Portuguese Tax Law (25%).

Prize money fund distribution, for men and ladies, is as follows:

1st place: 1800 €

2nd place: 800€

3rd place: 400€



# **RULES & GENERAL REGULATIONS:**

This Europa Cup will be held in accordance with Rules for Snowboard FIS Continental CUP 2012-2013 and Snowboard ICR Rules.

Number of competitors per nation is determined in accordance to the Rules for Snowboard FIS Continental Cups 2012-2013 and the FIS Continental Cup Quotas

National Associations are responsible for entering their competitors

Only athletes with valid FIS code may be entered
