# **Travel Information**

### AIRPORT SERVICE

At 9,078 feet above sea level, the Telluride Regional Airport is the world's second highest commercial airport. The following airports provide the best access to Telluride and Mountain Village.

#### Telluride Regional Airport (TEX)

Telluride Regional Airport is located five miles west of town. At an elevation of 9,080 feet above sea level, it is the second highest commercial airport in the world. Localizer/DME, VOR/DME, and GPS approaches. Serviced by Great Lakes. Upon arrival at Telluride Regional Airport you can take a shuttle to Telluride or Mountain Town.

#### Montrose Regional Airport (MTJ)

A short and beautiful 1.5 hour drive from Telluride. Getting here is easier than ever now, with year round access from Denver, and Houston. From December through March, there are also direct jet flights from Newark, Atlanta and Dallas/Ft. Worth. The Montrose Airport is 65 miles from Telluride and is serviced by Continental, United Express, and Delta and American Airlines.

#### Durango - La Plata County Airport (DRO)

Located approximately 3 hours southwest of Telluride, La Plata County Airport provides the major air access point for the Four Corners Region and attractions such as the Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad, Durango Mountain-Purgatory, Wolf Creek and Telluride ski areas, and Mesa Verde National Park. With a 9,200' runway, modern secure terminal, service from four air carriers, serving four hubs, including scheduled jet service from Phoenix, and, during ski season, Houston, the facility is truly a regional airport.





#### Grand Junction - Walker Field Airport (GJT)

A 2.5 hour drive from Telluride. Commercial carrier service with over 20 daily departures to Denver,

Phoenix and Salt Lake City and over 500 one-stop connections to cities in the United States, Canada, Europe and Central America. Easy access to major ski areas including Vail, Aspen, Telluride and Steamboat.

#### BY CAR

#### From Denver by Way of Grand Junction

Take Interstate 70 West to Grand Junction, go South on Route 50 to Montrose. Continue South on Route 550 to Ridgway then turn right onto Route 62. Follow this to Route 145 and turn left. Follow the signs into Telluride.Travel time - 7 hours.

#### From Colorado Springs

Take Route U.S. 24 West. Turn south on U.S. 285/24 and proceed to Route 50. Turn right on Route 50. Proceed over Monarch Pass onto Gunnison and finally Montrose. Turn left and go South on Route 550 to Ridgway then turn right onto Route 62. Follow this to Route 145 and turn left. Follow the signs into Telluride. Travel time - 6 hours.

#### From Durango

Follow Route 160 from Durango to Mancos. Turn right onto Route 184 towards Dolores. Turn Right onto Route 145 just south of Dolores. Follow 145 into Telluride. About 3 miles out of town, Route 145 will turn right. Telluride is three more miles. Travel time - 2.5 hours.

#### From Montrose

Follow N Townsend Avenue/US-50 through Montrose. N Townsend turns into US-550 S. In Ridgway, turn right onto CO-62. Turn left on CO-145, there is a sign showing a left turn to Telluride. Follow CO-145 for about 16 miles all the way straight into Telluride. The total distance is about 65 miles – travel time – 1.5 hours.
