- Holmenkollen is Norway's most visited tourist attraction and one of the most famous sports arenas in the world
- Holmenkollen has hosted the Winter Olympics (1952) and the FIS Nordic World Championships in 1930, 1966, 1982 and 2011.
- The arena is the gateway to Nordmarka, a very popular recreational area for the inhabitants of Oslo, the capital of Norway. From the ski jump tower, 60 meters above the ground and 417 meters above the sea level, you can experience a breath taking view of Oslo and the fjord below.
- The world's oldest ski museum is located in Holmenkollen arena. Holmenkollen Ski Museum presents over 4000 years of skiing history and polar exploration artifacts.
- Other popular tourist attractions located in Oslo are The Vigeland Sculpture Park (Vigelandsparken), The Norwegian Opera & Ballet (Den norske opera & ballet), The National Gallery (Nasjonalgalleriet), The Norwegian Museum of Science and Technology and The Viking Ship Museum (Vikingeskipsmuseet)
