General Information

1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants **by 11**th **November 2013**.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than <u>13th</u> <u>December 2013</u>.

Access to the online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage http://www.fis-ski.com / "Member Section".

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded: http://www.fis-ski.com/data/document/quotas-1314-1st-calculation.pdf

VISA

To travel to China, you are required to have a **Visa**. Please send the scanned passport copies to us. Once we have your team entries and passport copies, we will send you a letter of invitation **by name**. This invitation by name is required when you make an application for a visa. **Passport must be valid for at least half a year after you leave China. If you need to apply your visa in the country which is different from your nationality, please inform us.**

2. REGISTRATION

The registration will take place on Tuesday, December 16th, from 09:00--21:00 at the official hotel.

To be eligible for participation in the 2013/2014 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she

must have FIS Code with and prove this with a valid passport. All fees and deposits must be paid in cash or credit card upon registration.

3. ACCOMMODATION

As the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the US dollar or Euro in cash or credit card equivalent of 50 Swiss Francs per day and one single room will be provide to per country for a team official. An additional one (1) single room is CHF 100 to the FIS rate (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules). The accommodation for teams will from the dinner of 16th to the breakfast of 23rd. Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS Rate. The hotel rates for early arrival and late departure are available upon request.

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

4. TRANSPORTATION

Please specify Beijing Capital International Airport as your point of arrival. The Organizing Committee will help to arrange the pick-up and drop off at Beijing Capital International Airport. Please fill the travelling form if you need the transportation service.

50 USD per person is charged for the service of transportation between airport and hotel.

5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. 20 US dollars deposit per bib will be charged upon registration.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the stay in Beijing.
