Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants by **November 4th, 2013**.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the organizing committee **no later than December 6th, 2013.**

Check-in, team registration, race headquarters and team captains meetings will take place at the Ski-Inn Hotel RukaVillage Meeting Rooms. Team registration/lodging check-in will take place daily starting on **Wednesday**, 11th of **December**, from 11 am – 9 pm.

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies

Ski Resort Ruka

Ski resort Ruka hosted World Championships in 2005. Spectacular event with new freestyle events, half pipe and ski cross, were skied for the first time in freestyle World Championships. The World Cup event last year showed that Ruka has fantastic infrastructure and that it is a perfect spot for early season ski training.

The ski resort of Ruka is welcoming all the teams back and is offering early season training before the season opening.

The resort will prepare the mogul slope ready for training starting from middle of November.





Accommodation
