- The Orcières resort, French Ski Freestyle Association are organising an international Europa Cup Skicross competition, part of the 2014 FIS Freestyle Europa Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- This competition is a skicross event and is open to both men and women
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule and the program depending on snow conditions, weather or the decision of the competition jury
