







FIS FREESTYLE SKI CROSS WORLD CUP FINAL LA PLAGNE – FRANCE March 23rd, 2014

La Plagne ski resort and the French Ski Federation are pleased to invite all Freestyle Nations to attend the FIS ski cross Freestyle World Cup final which will be held at La Plagne on the 23rd of March 2014. The organizing committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition Rules of the International Ski Federation.

In order to help you with the preparation of your team's visit, you will find following all the information regarding the race.

2. Rules

- 2.1 The French Ski Federation and the La Plagne Committee are organising an international World Cup Freestyle competition, part of the 2014 FIS Freestyle World Cup Circuit.
- 2.2 The dates for the competition have been published in the international Calendar of the FIS.
- 2.3 The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- 2.4 The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- 2.5 The organizing committee and the French Ski Federation along with the jury reserve the right to change the schedule and the place of the event stated in the programme, depending on the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.



3. Entries

As this is the Season Final Ski Cross there are only the top 32 ladies and top 32 men allowed to participate.

The starting field will be limited to 32 ladies and 32 men (no Hosting Nation Quota) based on the World Cup Standings after the competition on March 16th, 2014. No qualification will take place and the seeding for the final will be based upon the Ski Cross World Cup Standings after 16.03.2014.

To help us better prepare for your visit, entries must be sent as soon as possible and no later than the 10th of February 2014 in order to benefit of accommodation/FIS rate.

4. Registration & means of payment

Team registration will take place in the Salle Omnisports in Plagne Centre (see included map). This is where you will find the accreditation office and the captain's meeting's room.

Team's registration will take place on Wednesday 19th of March from 9:00 to 17:00. Accreditation will have to be worn all the time and showed if required.

All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration in CHF or EUR and be paid in cash or credit card. **No cheques or travellers cheques will be accepted.**

5. Accommodation & Meals

Regarding accommodation, all the teams will be accommodated in half pension: 50 CHF (40,70€) per person and per day paid to the OC. Hotel assignment will be confirmed upon arrival at the race office. All teams must first register at the race office and get an accommodation voucher before heading to the assigned residence.

Teams will be accommodated from Wednesday 19th of March to Monday morning 24th of March 2014.

At the time of check in at your hotel, a fully refundable damage deposit (200€) charged to your credit card may be required (a credit card is mandatory). Please make sure that all the keys are returned to the reception desk of your residence before leaving the resort.

Each National Association (team) will be held responsible for any damage incurred during its stay.

These conditions will be applied only to the members registered using the online entry system.

Breakfast and dinner will be provided, commencing with dinner on Wednesday 19th and concluding with breakfast on Monday 24th of March 2014. Complete information and timetable will be provided upon check in at the competition headquarters.

A special AUDI End of season Freestyle Party where dinner will be served will be organized on sunday evening 23rd of March to celebrate this grand final and the end of this world cup season.

6. Team Captains Meetings

7. Bibs & helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions, flowers and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib.



8. Medical & Anti-doping

Anti-doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

9. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation. Please, for further information contact La Plagne tourist office directly tel: + 33 (0)4 79 09 02 01.

La Plagne resort offers free public bus transportation that runs daily and links all the altitude resorts.

9. Liability

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, La Plagne, the French freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event. All participants are urged no to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

10. Accident insurance

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, La Plagne, the FIS and the French Ski Association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims during the training and competitions.

11. Accident protocol

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.

12. Ski storage

A Ski room will be organized in a special room located next to your accommodation. Full information will be given upon arrival at the Competition Headquarters.

Skis will not be allowed in your flats.

13. Vehicle parking

Vehicles will be parked next to the race sites during the competition. A car accreditation will be given during registration to give access to the official race car park. Parking close to your accommodation will be organised.


