Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS World Cup quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) **by November 8, 2013. (WC Rule 7.6.3)**

The final number of your competition team and names of participants (including competitors and officials) must be submitted to the organizers **no later than December 10, 2013. (WC Rule 7.6.4)**
