# FIS TELEMARK WORLD CUP 2013-2014

## Les Contamines-Montjoie - France - December 20th to 23rd 2013

The French Ski Federation and the organising committee of the Telemark World Cup 2014 in "Les Contamines-Montjoie" are pleased to invite your national team to take part to this event from December 20<sup>th</sup> to December 23<sup>rd</sup> 2014.

To help you with the preparation of your team's visit, please read carefully all the information below.

#### 1 Program:

The FIS Telemark World Cup will take place in Les Contamines Montjoie – France from December 19<sup>th</sup> to December 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013. The complete program is the following one :

#### December Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> 2013: Arrival in Les Contamines.

Arrival day for all the teams and athletes (read next chapter for the accommodation information).

Race committee for the training day (to be confirmed with the FIS later).

#### December Friday 20<sup>th</sup> 2013: Training Day.

The stadium will be open to the teams and athletes from 10am to 15pm. It will be possible to train in GS. The loom and the jump will be open only if the snow condition permit it and if the race committee allow it.

7pm: Race committee for the race of Satruday in Espace Animation.

### December Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> 2013: Sprint race and opening ceremony.

4.30pm Press meeting in the race committee room.

6.00pm Opening ceremony and official prize giving ceremony of the Sprint in the village.

December Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> 2013: Parallel race, kid race and show race.

8.00am Skilift open. 8.30am – 9.30am Inspection.

9.45am Qualifications. 11.00am Lunch close to the finish area.
12.00pm Finals. 2.00pm Flowers ceremony in the finish area.

4.00pm KCC's (Telemark kid race).

6.00pm "Night Show race" for World Cup athletes on the slope close to the village.

8.00pm Prize giving ceremony for the Parallel Sprint, the kid race and the "Night Show race".

### December Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013: Sprint race and closing ceremony.

8.00am Skilift open. 8.30am – 9.45am Inspection.

10.00am 1<sup>st</sup> run. 11.00am Lunch close to the finish area. 12.30pm 2<sup>nd</sup> run. 2.30pm Flowers ceremony of the Sprin

12.30pm 2<sup>nd</sup> run. 2.30pm Flowers ceremony of the Sprint in the finish area. 4.00pm Closing ceremony and official prize giving ceremony of the Sprint and "Les Contamines Trophy" (overall of the 3 officials races in Les Contamines). Evening: Telemark party (place to be defined).

This program could be modified later if necessary.

The OC will organize a "Night Show race" on Sunday  $22^{nd}$  December at 6.00pm for all the World Cup racers. This is a non official race. The main objective is to create a great Telemark entertainment for the public in the light slope of the village. *The registration for this race have to be done by e-mail before Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> December by the national teams* (or the athletes): direction-sgat@lescontamines.com. The registration are free and the race will reward the top 3 ladies and top 3 men with a prize monney. The race format will be a X'Telemark which will be explained at the 1<sup>st</sup> race committee of Thursday  $19^{th}$  December 2013.

#### 2 Arrival and organizing centre:

Please note that the accommodation service of the organization is the only place for arrivals, check in and departure. This place is located in the Tourist Office at the door "Centrale de Réservation", between the entry of the Tourist Office and the entry of the French Ski School.

Arrival: From 3pm to 7pm on Tuesday 19th

This office will be open from 9am to 12pm and from 2pm to 6pm during the event (except Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> December).

Each official and competitor will receive an accreditation card from the OC providing free access to the competition site. The card must be worn at all time and showed if required.

The race office and Team captains meeting are located in the "Espace Animation" 200m up from the Tourist Office. You have to follow the harrow "Comité de course – Race committee".

#### 3 Entries:

According to the FIS rules, all national association affiliated with the FIS are invited to compete.

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by **December 1**<sup>st</sup> **2013.** 

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than December 8<sup>th</sup> 2013.

Competitors entered into FIS Telemark World Cups must have the minimum required FIS points in the valid FIS points list.

All Team registration must be received by the OC no later than December 1<sup>st</sup> 2013 Please not that we need your right number of racers expected to compete.

# 4 Bibs:

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official competition, flowers and awards ceremony.

#### 5 Insurance / Accident :

Every competitor and official must have their own medical insurance. All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend to participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The organising committee declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the event.

#### 6 Accommodation & food:

Accommodation for athletes and technical staff is provided in various apartments and hotels in Les Contamines-Montjoie and in the surrounding villages with half board vouchers : 4 nights from December Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup>. The FIS rate will be applied to all competitors and technical staff as 80€/person/day.

During the check in, each coach will pay the totality of the accommodation expenses and a fully refundable damage deposit charged to a major credit card will be required (a credit card is mandatory). Each National association will be held responsible for any damage incurred during its stay. Skis and grooming equipment as well as wax must be stored in a room and a place provided by the accommodation or the Organising Committee.

These conditions will be applied to the members registered on the entry form returned to the OC before December 1<sup>st</sup> 2013.

A completed rooming list must be sent before *December 8<sup>th</sup> 2013* with any wishes about room and place sharing.

The complete the first of being server become and place sharing.

For those who want an additional night, the same rate could be applied if the request is sent not later than December 1st 2013 otherwise it could not be guaranteed.

Any modification after  $\underline{December\ 8^{th}\ 2013}$  will occur cancellation fees and extra booking could not be guaranteed at the FIS rate.

The OC will provide breakfast, lunch and dinner. The lunch will be served in a tent close to the finish area. The dinner will be served around 7.30 pm - 8.00 pm for everybody in Les Contamines (Espace Animation) each evening from Thursday  $19^{\text{th}}$  to Sunday  $22^{\text{nd}}$  December 2013.

#### 7 Anti-Doping:

Anti-Doping control may be conducted.

#### 8 Prize Monney for the officials races (Sprint and Parallel Sprint):

The payment of the prize monney will be made after the award ceremony in cash. For the foreign racers, a 15% tax will be held to cover the French law.

The prize monney will be distributed at equal value for Ladies and Men podium:

Prize monney for the Sprint races:  $2^{\text{nd}}$ 275€  $3^{rd}$ 150€ 4<sup>th</sup> 75€ 5<sup>th</sup> 50€  $1^{st}$ Prize monney for the Parallel Sprint race: 500€  $2^{nd}$ 300€  $3^{rd}$ 200€

### 9 Security and medical plan:

The security of each race will be done by doctor, some qualified volunteers and the ski patrollers of the ski area.

A medical plan will be given at the 1<sup>st</sup> race committee to all the national teams.
