**2. ENTRIES**

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the provisional entries (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants by **November 3rd, 2014**.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the organizing committee **no later than December 5th, 2014**.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cup. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations.
