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INSTRUCTIONS FOR TEAMS:

Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit your team's provisional entries, for all team members (officials, service, coaches, athletes) by the 26th of October 2014.

Access to the online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage at <http://www.fis-ski.com/Member> Section. Entry deadline for all team members (officials, service, coaches, athletes) must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than November 27th, 2014.

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, all competitors and team officials will pay the Organizing Committee the CDN dollars (in cash or credit card) equivalent of 50 CHF per day (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules). Each coach has to pay his/her team accommodation expenses on arrival day. No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. **One (1) single room per country for a team official will be provided at 50 CHF per day.** An additional one (1) single room can be purchased at a rate of CHF 100. It is the responsibility of the team to determine who receives this room. Any additional single rooms requested will be provided only if available and at market rate.

Wax rooms will be at the Delta Hotel located in the underground parking lots. Rooms will be allocated according to team size and entries.



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Transportation

Transportation will be the responsibility of the teams. All international flights will be into Calgary Airport (YYC).

Registration

Race Office

Liability

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

Accident Insurance

Every competitor must have his or her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on-course during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision to local hospital in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

Medical and Anti-Doping

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.



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
