### 1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

### 2. REGISTRATION

Team registration will take place on February 25 and 26, 2015 from 9am to 5pm at the Race Office, on the 1st floor at the Hotel Komagatake Grand Hotel.

As per the FIS Rule on accommodations, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the Japanese YEN equivalent of CHF50 (JPY 5,776) per day. The FIS Rule on accommodations is not applied in any accommodations other than the Komagatake Grand Hotel.

Payment for your accommodations required with accepted credit card or cash. Accepted cards: VISA, American Express, MasterCard or JCB.

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not subject to the FIS rate. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during its stay. Extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves directly to the hotel.

Freestyle Skiing WC Rule 4.4: One single room per country will be provided. An additional single room would be at the rate at CHF 100 (JPYen 11,552) per day.

### 4. TRANSPORTATION

We strongly recommend that you fly into <u>the Akita Airport</u>, the nearest airport to the Tazawako Ski Resort.

The Organizing Committee will provide chartered bus between the Akita Airport and the Komagatake Grand Hotel for free for teams on specific dates and time.
