



## Invitation Ski Team Sweden Roll Cup 2015

Swedish Ski Association with organizers hereby invites to the second edition of the Ski Team Sweden Swedish Cup Roll cup – the national Swedish cup for roller ski.

The cup is a collaboration between Swedish Ski Association, Idre Fjäll, Särna-Idre SK, Stockholm Challenge (OK Södertörn and OK Ravinen) and Alliansloppet (Trollhättan's sports clubs) in order to spread the roller ski sport and cross-country skiing in the summer.

**Races:** The cup consists of five races, all of which are counted in the overall cup. The races are FIS level. The lady and the gentleman with the most points after the final race is the winner of the cup.

**Race dates:**

**27 June, Stockholm**

**7-8 August, Idre**

**21-22 August, Trollhättan**

**Classes:** Ladies and men senior. Ladies and men junior. Racers must according to the FIS regulations have an active cross-country skiing FIS-code to participate in the overall cup.

For other classes organized during the events FIS code are not required.

**Technique:** online or each organizers website or invitation.

**Entries:** Each organizer determines the entry method, see respective website.

## Cup points: According to the FIS World Cup table.

1st place = 100 points 16th place = 15 points  
2nd place = 80 points 17th place = 14 points  
3rd place = 60 points 18th place = 13 points  
4th place = 50 points-19th place = 12 points  
5th place = 45 points-20th place = 11 points  
6th place = 40 points 21st place = 10 points

8th place = 32 points 23rd place = 8 points  
9th place = 29 points 24th place = 7 points  
10th place = 26 points 25th place = 6 points

Foreign athletes are entitled to participate in all cup races and the overall cup, under the same conditions as Swedish athletes.

If the same final score after the last race will happen, the following applies:

1. The highest number of victories is placed before.
2. Best intermediate result is placed before.
3. If riders still have the same point both athletes will be awarded with the same price.

**Prices:** At the races each organizer is responsible for the price table.

In the total cup prize fund is 75 000 sek for the seniors and training camps for the juniors that are distributed as follows:

**Prize money for the total cup will be paid to the athletes ski club as a training scholarship or to the athletes own company via an invoice.**

Swedish Ski Association (Ludvig Remb) is responsible for payment of the prize money for the total cup.

**Wheels:** All cup races in classic technique are organized on slow wheels (type 2). Racing wheels of PU-type are prohibited.

"Wheels regulations Ski Team Sweden Roll cup 2015" is the regulations that apply in these competitions.

**Respect the regulations – controls of wheels will be implemented.**

All cup races in free technique are organized on "free wheels" (racing wheels).

**Security:** All athletes must according to the FIS regulations use helmet and goggles (shatterproof glass) at all races.

**Seeding:** Seeding of 20 men and 10 women (senior and junior) will be made at all races.

Seeding is used according to the current cup standings (top 20 men, top 10 ladies) plus a number of "wildcards" that the organizer hands out depending on who participates.

To the first race the FIS distance points will be used for 20 men and 10 women as well as the number of wildcard the organizer have handed out.

Seeded athletes will start in own row in front of the rest of the starting field. Seeded juniors will start in the same row as the seeded seniors or in an own row right behind the seniors row before the second row.

At sprint races 20 men and 10 women are seeded in the prologue as follows: first by ROL WC sprint standings, second by the FIS sprint points and third by drawing.

## Wheel regulations Ski Team Sweden Roll Cup 2015

Swedish Ski Association (SSA) working group for roller skiing has determined the following regulations for wheels at the competitions in Ski Team Sweden Roll cup 2015 if an organizer does not provide loan of skis to the athletes.

- Arrive in time for the measurement of skis. The measurement will be made only on the day of the competition and those who did not had time to measure their skis will not be permitted to start.
- Measurement could take place for all seeded athletes before the start and after finish. Among exercisers, samples can be carried out.
- Wheels softer than the limit value SSA measured will not be permitted to use. Racing wheels (type 1) are not allowed. This is regardless of what mark there are at the wheel. Note that most standard wheels on the market are approved.
- If an athlete has a pair of skis that go beyond the limit exists, the skier will be able to borrow skis that are measured by the SSA.
- SSA equipment controller decision concerning loan of skis or not applies – otherwise the athlete is not permitted to start.
- Only the equipment that SSA or the organizer uses on race day is accepted as measuring equipment.
- If refusal or deviation from the control will occur the athlete immediately will be disqualified and any prizes shall be returned to the organizer.
