1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules.

By **11th January 2016** - please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the Organizing Committee no later than **10th February 2016**.

Access to the online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage <http://www.fis-ski.com/> “Member Section”

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Freestyle Ski points in the respective valid FIS points list. The minimum FIS point entry requirements for FIS Freestyle Aerials 50 FIS points.

VISA

To travel to Belarus, you are required to have a **Visa**. Once we have your team entries, we will send a letter of invitation **by name**. This invitation by name is the requirement when you make an application for a visa.

2. REGISTRATION

The registration will start at the official hotel on **February 16th**, from 09:00.

To be eligible for participation in the 2015/2016 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have a FIS Code and prove it with a valid passport. All fees must be paid **by credit card**. Accepted for payment the following cards: **VISA, VISA electron, MasterCard, MasterCard electron, Maestro**.

3. ACCOMMODATION

As per the FIS Rule for accommodation and half board, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the US dollar or Euro **by credit card** equivalent of 50 Swiss Francs per night and one single room will be provide to per country for a team official. For an additional single room will pay equivalent of 100 Swiss Francs to the FIS rate (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules).

The accommodation will be provided from the dinner of 16th February to the breakfast of 21st 2016.

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS Rate. The hotel rates for early arrival and late departure are available upon request. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

4. TRANSPORTATION

Please specify Minsk-2 Airport or Minsk Railway station as your point of arrival.

The Organizing Committee will help to arrange the transfer of teams from Minsk-2 Airport and Minsk Railway station and back.

30 USD per person is charged for the service of transportation between Airport or Railway station and hotel.

5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

20 US dollars deposit (in cash) per bib will be charged upon registration.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

9. MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
