**Invitation**

The Centre d'Excellence Acrobatique de Val Saint-Côme (CEAVSC) and the Organizing Committee (OC) are pleased to invite all eligible freestyle skiers, coaches and fans to attend the 2016 NorAm Cup to be held at Val Saint-Côme (VSC), Québec, Canada on February 25–28th, 2016.

The Competition is comprised of four (4) events, two (2) Aerials, one (1) Single Moguls and one (1) Dual Moguls in accordance with the attached program.

**General Information**

**Date and Location**

Aerials (AE) competitions will take place on Thursday, February 25th and Friday, February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016, at Val Saint-Côme on the Nicolas-Fontaine course. AE training will begin on Tuesday, February 23, 2016.

Moguls (MO) competitions will take place on Saturday, February 27<sup>th</sup> (Single Moguls) and Sunday, February 28<sup>th</sup> (Dual Moguls) at Val Saint-Côme on the Alexandre-Bilodeau course. MO training will begin on Thursday, February 25, 2016.

**Rules**

The Fédération Internationale de Ski ("FIS") is sanctioning this Competition. The Organizing Committee of the event will host the competition in accordance with the FIS Freestyle Ski NorAm Cup rules.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- Under the guiding FIS rules for Continental Cups, athletes need to qualify for this event through a quota system and will be allocated a spot through their National Sport Organizations (NSO). Please contact your NSO to inquire about a spot.
- All athletes entered in a NorAm Cup competition must hold a valid FIS License issued under the authority of their national ski association and conform to the rules in the FIS ICR Sections 203 and 204.

MO entries must be received no later than, Thursday, February 4, 2016 at 17:00.

AE entries must be received no later than Tuesday, February 2, 2016 at 17:00

Entry Fees for each participant are **CAD\$ 180.00** for one event or **CAD\$ 300.00** for two events.
