WinSport Academy and the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association are pleased to invite all *experienced competitive* to attend the **Halfpipe & Slopestyle NORAM February 25-28, 2016**. This FIS Nor-Am is also an AFP Gold level sanctioned event in slopestyle and halfpipe skiing.

#### Rules

- 1. The event is sanctioned by the Canadian Ski Association and FIS, and organized by WinSport Academy and in partnership with the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association.
- 2. The competition is comprised of two events.( Halfpipe and Slopestyle)
- 3. All athletes participating in the FIS Nor-Am must have valid FIS licence issued under the authority of their national ski association and conform to the rules of FIS ICR Section 203 and 204.
- 4. Proof of Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers for Canadian competitors.
- 5. The competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.

#### **Lift Tickets**

Lift tickets will be available for purchase each day of training and competition at Guest Services with presentation of competitor bib, cost is \$25/day +GST. Each competition is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of the event.

Competition office – The race office will be located on the main floor of the east wing of the Frank King daylodge all week. All participants must check in and register on-site at the registration desk to confirm participation in the event and to pick up competition bibs.

#### **Bib Deposit**

There will be a **\$20 CASH ONLY** bib deposit. If a bib is lost or forgotten, there will be a \$20 replacement fee. An athlete's bib number must match event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace your bib, please ensure the on-site registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

#### Refunds

Once an athlete is participates is confirmed on the start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury, the coach or parent must notify the registration desk, or email <a href="mailto:pat.mcleod@winsport.com">pat.mcleod@winsport.com</a> to inform that the athlete is injured and unable to ski <a href="mailto:BEFORE">BEFORE</a> competition day. Athletes are entitled to partial refunds, \$30 per event. A doctor's note must be presented at time of refund.

If an event is cancelled due to weather or exceptional circumstances, no refund will be issued. The organizing committee has already incurred all the costs of the event.

#### **Aerial Qualifications**

All Canadian athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- 1. Signed Aerial Passports held by coach/athlete
- 2. Completed and signed qualification forms
- 3. CFSA qualification databank

#### **Statement of Liability Accident Insurance**

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and lift insurance that is adequate and covers and manoeuvres being performance in training and competition, as well as a valid CFSA membership. The Organizing Committee, CFSA, WinSport Academy and WinSport's Canada Olympic Park shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second or third party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.

#### **Accident Insurance**

Every Competitor must have his/own medical insurance in accordance with the FIS ICR rule 204.2 The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, WinSport's Canada Olympic Park, Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, Canada Snowsports Association, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers and FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims during the staging of the event.

## **Slopestyle and Halfpipe Heat Format**

Qualifications will be scheduled in heats with the best of two runs counting. The number of heats is dependent on the number of athletes registered for the competition. Top 12 scores will advance to finals. Draw for the Halfpipe heats will be set on Friday at the Team Captains Meeting and heats for Slopestyle will be set on Saturday at the Team Captains Meeting. Ties in qualifications, will be decided by the highest other run score. From qualifications, no more than 12 ladies and 12 men will advance to ski the 2 run final.
