General Information

1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants **by 9th November 2015**.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than **9th December 2015**.

Access to the online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations.

VISA Invitation

To travel to China, you are required to have a **Visa**. Please send us the photocopies of passports in advance. As soon as receiving your team entries and passport copies, we will prepare and send you a visa invitation **by names**. This invitation is required when you submit your visa application to the respective Chinese embassy. **Please also note that all passport must be valid for at least half a year after you leave China. If you need to apply your visa in the country which is different from your nationality, please inform us.**

2. REGISTRATION

The registration will start on December 14th (Monday) from 09:00--21:00 at the official hotel.

To be eligible for participation in the 2015/2016 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association, and must have the FIS Code and a

valid passport. All fees and deposits need be paid in cash or credit card upon the registration.

3. ACCOMMODATION

According to the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the US dollar or Euro in cash or credit card equivalent of **CHF 50.00** per day and one single room will be provide to per country for a team official. **An additional one (1) single room is CHF 100.00 to the FIS rate** (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules). **The accommodation for teams will start from the dinner of 14th to the breakfast of 21st. Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS Rate. The hotel rates for early arrival and late departure are available upon request.**

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

4. TRANSPORTATION

Please specify Beijing Capital International Airport as your destination of arrival. The Organizing Committee will help to arrange the pick-up and drop off at Beijing Capital International Airport. Please fill the travelling form if you need the transportation service.

USD 50.00 per person is charged for the service of round transportation between airport and hotel.

5. BIBS

All competitors need to wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. USD 20.00 deposit per bib will be charged upon registration.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the stay in Beijing.

8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision to local hospital in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

9. MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
