## 2. Rules

- 2.1 The French Ski Federation and the La Plagne Committee are organising an international World Cup Freestyle competition, part of the 2016 FIS Freestyle World Cup Circuit.
- 2.2 The dates for the competition have been published in the international Calendar of the FIS.
- 2.3 The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- 2.4 The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- 2.5 The organizing committee and the French Ski Federation along with the jury reserve the right to change the schedule and the place of the event stated in the programme, depending on the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.

### 3. Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants by the 6th of december, 2015 as per rule 7.6.3 in the Rules for the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than the 5th of january, 2016 as per rule 7.6.4 in the Rules for the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup.

Access to the online registration system is through the FIS Homepage <http://www.fis-ski.com> the go to Member Section. FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded :

**To help us better prepare for your visit, entries must be sent as soon as possible and no later than the 6<sup>th</sup> of December 2015 in order to benefit of accommodation/FIS rate.**

### 4. Registration & means of payment

**Team registration will take place in the Salle Omnisports in Plagne Centre (see included map). This is where you will find the accreditation office and the captain's meeting's room.**

Team's registration will take place on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> of January from 13:00 to 19:30. Accreditation will have to be worn all the time and showed if required.

All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration in EUR and be paid in cash or credit card. **No cheques or travellers cheques will be accepted.**

### 5. Accommodation – Meals – Wax rooms

Teams will be hosted for lodging and meals at different partner hotels and residences as per the FIS World Cup rules (5 nights at the FIS rate, CHF 50 for athletes & coaches and at CHF70 for service personnel) from Tuesday january 12th to Sunday january 17th.

One single room per country will be provided. It is the responsibility of the team to determine who receives this room. If a 2nd single room is requested, it will be charged at the equivalent of 100 Swiss Francs. Any additional single rooms requested will be provided only if available and at market rate.

**Official Arriving Day :** 12th january

**Official Departure Day :** 17th january

Hotel assignment will be confirmed before arrival by the race office.

At the time of checking in at your hotel, a fully refundable damage deposit (250€) charged to your credit card may be required (a credit card is mandatory). Please make sure that all the keys are returned to the reception desk of your residence before leaving the resort.

Each National Association (team) will be held responsible for any damage incurred during its stay.

These conditions will be applied only to the members registered using the online entry system.

Breakfast and dinner will be provided, commencing with dinner on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> january and concluding with breakfast on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> January. Complete information and timetable will be provided upon check in at the competition headquarters.

A Wax room will be organized in a special room located next to your accommodation. Full information will be given upon arrival at the Competition Headquarters. Skis will not be allowed in your flats.

## 7. Bibs & helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions, flowers and award ceremony and public draw (bib only). Please see schedule. A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib.

## 8. Medical & Anti-doping

Anti-doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

---

## 9. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation. Please, for further information contact La Plagne tourist office directly tel: + 33 (0)4 79 09 02 01. La Plagne resort offers free public bus transportation that runs daily and links all the altitude resorts.

## 10. Liability

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, La Plagne, the French freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event. All participants are urged no to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

## 11. Accident insurance

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, La Plagne, the FIS and the French Ski Association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims during the training and competitions.

## 12. Accident protocol

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.

---

## 13. Vehicle parking

Vehicles will be parked next to the race sites during the competition. A car accreditation will be given during registration to give access to the official race car park and must be placed, visible, in the car. Parking close to your accommodation will be organised.

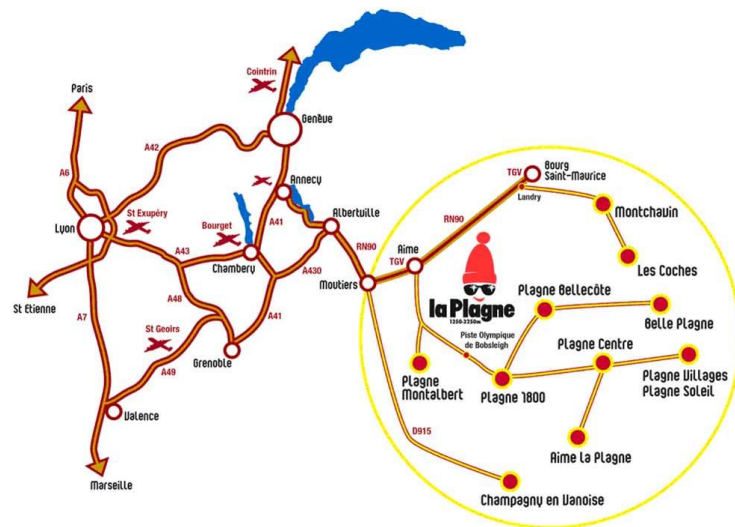
