## FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup – Team Invitation

The 2016 Visa U.S. Grand Prix at Park City Mountain Halfpipe competition will be held as a FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup and Association of Freeskiing Professional Platinum Level events. Athletes will compete for a piece of over 50,000 CHF in prize money.

### **Registration (FIS Online Registration System)**

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup quotas and rules. Submit preliminary team entry with anticipated team size (including competitors and officials) by **December 25, 2015**. Final entries (including names of participants) must be submitted to organizers **no later than January 24, 2016**.
