FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup – Team Invitation

The 2016 Visa U.S. Grand Prix Big Air at Fenway Park competition will be held as a FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup and Association of Freeskiing Professional Platinum Level event. Athletes will compete for a piece of \$75,000 in prize money.

Registration (FIS Online Registration System)

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup quotas and rules. Submit preliminary team entry with anticipated team size (including competitors and officials) by **January 3, 2016**. Final entries (including names of participants) must be submitted to organizers ***no later than February 2, 2016***.

Special quota calculation has been agreed on by both FIS and the Organizing Committee for this competition only.
