General Information

Date and location:

The competition will take place January 30, 2016 at the Centre of Excellence Acrobatic Val St-Come, Nicolas Fontaine site.

Additional Training Notice:

The Centre of Excellence Acrobatic Val St Come, is offering 2 training block opportunities out side of the official training:

Training Block #1 – January 3-11th, 2016

Training Block #2 – January 24-28th, 2016

Training Access Fee:

Training block #1 and/or #2 only - access fee will be \$85/athlete/day.

Training block #1 and/or #2 and the competition - access fee will be \$35/athlete/day.

- Slope access to air site. * Does not include access to full resort.

Registration for Competition - Registrations must be received by Monday, January 25, 2016.

A registration fees are **\$180** for Open Category, **\$50** for Provincial event. Registration fee will be payable on site by the head coach of each team, either in cash or by cheque (payable to: Federation Quebecoise de Ski Acrobatique).

Refunds:

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury the coach or parent must notify the registration desk, to inform that an athlete is injured and unable to ski **before** competition day. Athletes are entitled to partial refunds, \$25 per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. Please see the Can Freestyle Competition Guide.

License Requirements:

All athletes are required to have a minimum of a FIS license to compete.

Two qualification runs. First Qualification round, each athlete jumps once. Second qualification run, top 6 athletes from first qualifier advance to finals and remaining athletes get one jump. From qualifications, 12 athletes advance to finals. F1 – 12 athletes, top 6 athletes advance to F2.

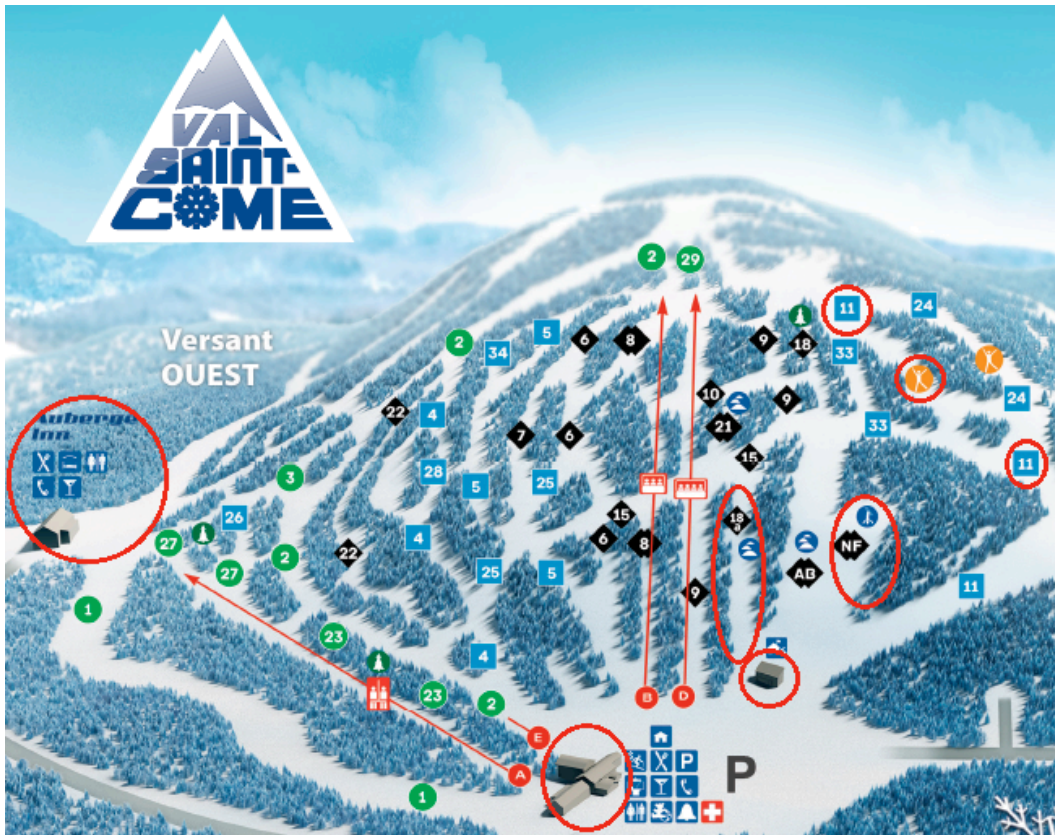
