1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules.

Each National Association may delegate maximum of 4 ladies and 4 men.

The age limits are referenced in ICR 3046.

The admitted years of birth for Aerials: 1996-2001.

By 15th January 2016 - please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the Organizing Committee no later than 17th February 2016.

VISA

To travel to Belarus, you are required to have a **Visa**. Once we have your team entries, we will send a letter of invitation **by name**. This invitation by name is the requirement when you make an application for a visa.















2. REGISTRATION

The registration will start at the official hotel on **February 24th**, from 09:00.

To be eligible for participation in the FIS Freestyle Junior World Ski Championships (Aerials), each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have a FIS Code and prove it with a valid passport. All fees must be paid by credit card. Accepted for payment the following cards: VISA, VISA electron, MasterCard, MasterCard electron, Maestro.

3. ACCOMMODATION

As per the FIS Rule for accommodation and half board, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the US dollar or Euro **by credit card** equivalent of 80 Swiss Francs per night.

The accommodation will be provided from the dinner of 24th February to the breakfast of 28th 2016.

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability.

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

4. TRANSPORTATION

Please specify Minsk-2 Airport or Minsk Railway station as your point of arrival.

The Organizing Committee will help to arrange the transfer of teams from Minsk-2 Airport and Minsk Railway station and back.

30 USD per person is charged for the service of transportation between Airport or Railway station and hotel.















5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

20 US dollars deposit (in cash) per bib will be charged upon registration.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

7. PROGRAM (changes are possible)

February 26th: Friday Official Training / Team Captains Meeting (Draw)

February 27th: Saturday Competition Day February 28th: Sunday Departure Day

8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

9. MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
