The 2016 U.S. Grand Prix at Park City Mountain Halfpipe competition will be held as a FIS Snowboard World Cup and World Snowboard Tour International Level events. Athletes will compete for a piece of over 50,000 CHF prize money.

Registration (FIS Online Registration System)

Entries will be accepted from National Snowboard Associations following FIS Snowboard World Cup quotas and rules. Please submit preliminary team entry with anticipated team size (including competitors and officials) by **January 2, 2016**. Final entries (including names of participants) must be submitted to organizers **no later than January 25, 2016**.
