





FIS SNOWBOARD - TEAM INVITATION

The 2016 Revolution Tour at Winter Park Slopestyle competitions, will be FIS sanctions and World Snowboarding Tour (WST) National Level Events.

Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Snowboard Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the final team entries with a FIS Entry Form (ICR Art. 215) to Larkin Jameson at Ijameson@ussa.org before *February 25, 2016*

Special International Team Quotas:

Each Nation will receive 1 spot per gender per discipline with any remaining spots (up to 25 counting both genders) given to competitors according to their standing on the current points list (FIS or WSPL points list – whichever is higher). Gender allocation of any remaining spots will be based on a ratio of 60% for men and 40% for ladies. All remaining spots, after the above gender allocation formula, not taken by one gender can be transferred to the other gender. Maximum quota (of International Spots) per Nation is 5 regardless of rank.

Submission of Re-Allocated International Spots:

List all athletes, according to their most current ranking (FIS or WSPL points list), that you wish to be considered for any available re-allocated spots. Please include them within your team FIS Entry Form. Teams will be contacted by the Organizing Committee 1-3 days after the final entry deadline informing them if additional athletes were accepted based on available spots and athletes standing on the current FIS or WSPL points list.
