Munich (MUC) International Airport, approximately 160 km away. Innsbruck Airport (INN), 125 km south - east, Memmingen Airport (FMM), 75 km north of Oberjoch.

Rail Connections: Direct connections to the 7-km-distant target train station Sonthofen, to be reached from all regions of Germany. Then further on with the holiday bus to Bad Hindelang, once every half hour.

Private Transport/by road: Coming from the north: Via the A 7/E 532 until the exit 137 (Oy-Mittelberg, Hindelang-Oberjoch) and from there via the B 310 to Oberjoch/ Bad Hindelang


ORGANISATION
