4. Payment (World Cup Rules Art. 10 and 13)

- Accommodation costs: Teams will pay directly in their hotels (persons from the pay lists will be paid by the OC directly).
- Carrying costs/Reimbursement :
 - Payment on Friday 09/12/2016 after TCM (17:00) at InterContinental Hotel
 - All payment will be done by bank transfer

5. Waxing facilities (World Cup Rules Art. 14)

- Wax cabins : available from Monday 05/12/2016 at 13:00
- Waxing trucks: teams arriving with trucks have to inform the OC before 01/10/2016 with exact measurements of the truck and details of the needs

- The keys to the cabins are available at the "Tent-Still". The deposit is EURO or CHF 50.00. Keys return on the day of departure.
- Teams using the wax cabins longer than 12/12/2016 have to inform the OC before 30/10/2016. The fee for longer use is CHF 50.00 per day and cabin.

Please be aware that Switzerland is NOT a member of the European Custom Union.

ATA Carnet

The ATA Carnet is an international document for the temporary, duty-free admission of goods. With the ATA Carnet Swiss and foreign customs formalities are completed using one form. The ATA Carnet can be obtained from Chambers of Commerce and Industry and releases the holder from any obligation to provide a guarantee when crossing the border. In Switzerland the Chambers of Commerce and Industry provide information on the conditions for receiving a Carnet, please see http://www.cci.ch/.

The ATA Carnet may be used for several border crossings and is valid for one year. Instead of national customs documents, the ATA Carnet can be used for imports, exports and transits purposes. The advantage is the swift passage through customs. The ATA Carnet has a uniform appearance for all contracting parties to the Convention on Temporary Admission of 26 June 1990 (the so-called Istanbul Convention). It can be used in more than 60 countries.

When opening the ATA Carnet, the complete description of the goods must be (cover sheet reverse) present. For the holder of the ATA Carnet, it is always possible to bring the goods back into the domestic customs territory.

The use of the Carnet ATA is applied to durable goods but not to nondurable goods. The most important areas of application of the ATA Carnet are as follows:

- Goods for display or use at exhibitions and fairs
- Professional equipment
- Commercial samples for display purposes (watches, jewellery, clothes, etc.)
- Sports equipment







Davos (SUI) to La Clusaz (FRA):



- Follow Route 28 and than A13 direktion Zürich
- Merge onto A 13 -
- Continue on A3
- At the interchange 32-Zürich-Süd, follow signs for A3 toward Basel/Bern
- Continue on A3
- At the interchange 59-Limmattaler Kreuz, follow signs for E60/A1/A3toward Bern/Basel
- Continue on A1/13/E60 follwo sings for Bern/Aarau
- At the interchange 37-Wankdorf, follow signs for E25/E27/A1 toward Lausanne/Fribourg
- Continue on A1/E25/E27 floow sign for Lusanne/Yverdon
- At the interchange 17-Ecublens, follow signs for E25/E62/A1 toward Genève
- Continue on A1/E25/E26 follow signs for France/Genève-La Praill
- Keep right to continue on A1 Continue onto A41
- Take the A40/E21/E62 exit toward Paris/Lyon/Annecy
- Follow signs forA40/E25/Turin/Chamonix-Mont Blanc/Milan and merge ontoA40/E25
- Keep left at the fork to continue on A40
- Take exit 16-Bonneville toward Bonneville
