



Invitation STS Roll Cup 2017

Swedish Ski Association with organizers hereby invites to the fifth edition of the Ski Team Sweden Roll cup (STS Roll cup) – the official national Swedish cup for roller skiing.

The cup is collaboration between Swedish Ski Association, SK Bore, Östersunds SK and Alliansloppets SK in order to promote the roller ski sport and cross-country skiing in the summer.

Races: The cup consists of nine races for seniors and juniors, all races are counted in the overall cup, all races are FIS events. The lady and the gentleman with the most points after the final race is the winner of the cup.

Race dates:

26-28 May, Torsby 17-18 June, Östersund 25-26 August, Trollhättan, three races

Classes: Ladies and men senior, ladies and men junior. Athletes must according to the ICR have an active cross-country skiing FIS-code to participate in the events that are in the FIS calendar.

For other classes organized during the events a FIS code is not required.

Distances/ See the list at the end of this invitation, the FIS calendar **Technique:** or each organizers website or invitation.

Entries: Each organizer determines the entry method, see respective invitation.

Cup points: According to the FIS stage event table.

Foreign athletes are eligible to participate in all events that are organized in the cup.

Foreign athletes are counting to the overall cup and will receive prizes if they are in the top of the general classification at the end of the season.

If the same final score after the last race will happen, the following applies:

- 1. The highest number of victories is placed before.
- 2. Best intermediate result is placed before.
- 3. If riders still have the same point both athletes will be awarded with the same price.
- **Prices:** Each organizer is responsible for the price table and pays price money in the senior categories as follows:

Total minitour in Torsby, ladies and men (totally 30 000 SEK): 1st 6.000 SEK 2nd 4.000 SEK 3rd 2.000 SEK 4th 1.500 SEK 5th 1.000 SEK 6th 500 SEK

After each race in Östersund, ladies and men (totally 30 000 SEK): 1st 3.000 SEK 2nd 2.000 SEK 3rd 1.000 SEK 4th 750 SEK 5th 500 SEK 6th 250 SEK

Price money for the total cup at the final in Trollhättan, ladies and men (totally 45 000 SEK): 1st 7.500 SEK 2nd 5.500 SEK 3rd 4.500 SEK 4th 2.500 SEK 5th 1.500 SEK 6th 1.000 SEK

Juniors will receive commodity prizes at the events in Torsby and Östersund, se respective invitation.

For the total cup the top three juniors ladies and men will receive commodity prizes from Elpex Rollerskis.



Wheels: The local OC in cooperation with SWE NSA decide whether fast or slow wheels will be allowed for each event. See each invitation from the organizers.

Respect the regulations – controls of wheels will be implemented.

- **Security:** All athletes must according to ICR use helmet and goggles (shatterproof glass) at all races.
- **Seeding:** Seeding of 20 men and 10 women (senior and junior) will be made at all races except at stage two and three of the mini tour in Torsby.

Seeding is used according to the current cup standings (top 20 men, top 10 ladies) plus the number of "wildcards" that the organizer hands out depending on who participates.

To the first race the FIS distance points will be used for 20 men and 10 women as well as the number of wildcard the organizer have handed out.

In mass start events seeded athletes will start in own row in front of the rest of the starting field. Seeded juniors will start in the same row as the seeded seniors or in an own









row right behind the seniors row before the second row.

At sprint races 20 men and 10 women are seeded in the prologue as follows: first by ROL WC sprint standings, second by the FIS sprint points and third by drawing.

Results: Are published on the official web site for the cup <u>www.skidor.com/rollcup</u>, each OC's web site and in the FIS and SWE NSA calendar.

Other

information:

The event in Torsby is a mini tour. Entry is only allowed once and if an athlete abandons a race the athlete is allowed to start in the rest of the stages but will not be counted in the total mini tour. All stages counts in the total cup and the final classification in the mini tour also counts to the total STS Roll Cup.

The starting order at the second stage is according to the results from the first stage. The athlete who won the first stage will be seeded first in the starting field.

In the total mini tour the racing time after each stage will be added together and will be the starting list for the last stage. The athlete who reaches the finish line first on the last stage will win the mini tour.

Bonus seconds will be distributed as follows:

Stage 1 At finish: 1st place = 30 seconds 2nd place = 27 seconds 3rd place = 24 seconds 4th place = 23 seconds 5th plats = 22 seconds

Stage 2 Bonus Sprint (the location will be announced by the OC): 1st place= 15 seconds 2nd place = 12 seconds 3rd place = 10 seconds

At finish: 1st place = 30 seconds 2nd place = 27 seconds 3rd place = 24 seconds

No bonus seconds will be distributed during stage 3.

For detailed information about each event please visit respective organizers web site.

In the event of postponing a race the organizer has the right to charge an additional 50% of the registration fee according to the SSA's rules.

If a race is cancelled 50% of the entry fee will be refunded according to SSA's rules.
