#### **2. ENTRIES**

**Preliminary entries** will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit your preliminary entries with the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) **by Sunday, December 4, 2016 / 04.12.2016.** 

In agreement with the FIS, your **Final Entries** (final names of your competition participants including competitors and officials) must be received by organizer **no later than Tuesday**, **January 3**, **2017** / **03.01.2017**.

#### Members Section

**FIS has established nation Quotas** for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup. Freestyle Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations.

All participant must have a minimum of 25 FIS points to compete (new rule of the WC rules n°13.1.4).

All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the Registration Area for check-in before proceeding to the Halfpipe competition venue. All fees will be collected upon check-in.

#### Participation Fee: 100 EUR

#### **3. REGISTRATION**

Team registration will take place at the Race Office, which will be located at:

"Châlet des Airelles" 66120 FONT-ROMEU Longitude 2,0353 / Latitude 42,5204

Team registration/lodging check-in will take place daily beginning on January 10th from 3:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

To be eligible for participation in the 2017 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup each competitor must be a citizen of a country from the National Ski Association, with a license and prove this with a valid passport.

#### 4. ACCOMMODATIONS

Teams will be responsible for their own accommodations. The organizing committee can provide some negotiated accommodations in half board from 65 euros to 80 euros per day per people. Please check more information in attachment.
