RULES

- The competitions are organized at Sunny Valley alpine resort, Miass, Russia by the joint Organizing Committee for the FIS World Cup Series 2016/2017 and are conducted under the rules and regulations for freestyle skiing competitions of the International Ski Federation (ICR and WCR).
- The dates of the competitions are published in the FIS International Competition Calendar.
 Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the schedule of the event from the one
 stated in the program, depending on snow conditions or the decision of the competition
 Jury.
- 3. The program includes one event for both ladies and men.

ENTRIES

Entries are accepted from National Ski Associations via FIS on-line entry system in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. Deadlines:

preliminary entries – January 15, 2017 confirmed entries – February 14, 2017















VISA SUPPORT

Most foreign citizens require a visa to enter Russia.

Please, check with your local Russian Embassy or Consulate to determine if you need a visa to travel to Russia, and which regulations apply in your case. Contacts of Russian consulates are posted on the website of the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs www.mid.ru (direct link to the MFA website)

Please, inform the OC if you require a visa invitation. Invitation issue process may take several days. To avoid delays with visas make sure all data is submitted to the OC before February 5, 2017.

Attached you will find our step-by-step 'Russian Visa Application Guide' (see Annex 2) created for your reference. It includes a substantial description of the application process as well as a list of what you need to provide the OC with to request visa support.

ACCREDITATION

By filling out and sending us the visa invitation request form and appropriate image files you automatically submit a request for accreditation. Bearers of FIS seasonal accreditation cards will receive an additional badge from the OC for venue access. All badges will be handed over to team/group representatives upon arrival and are necessary for entering the venue including team hotels.

TRANSPORTATION

Participants are responsible for their own transportation. Sunny Valley alpine resort is located 120 km away from the airport of Chelyabinsk, 250 km away from the airport of Ekaterinburg or 14 km away from the Miass train station of the Trans-Siberian Railway.

The OC offers transfers from the airport of Chelyabinsk to the resort (busses and trucks for the equipment at the lowest possible rate). Transfer requests are to be sent to race@rsaski.ru. To request a transfer, please, provide the following information:

- 1. Arrival/departure date, time, flight numbers, destination (from/to)
- 2. Amount of passengers and all names of participants in a group
- 3. Amount of luggage in pieces and its approximate total weight

Local transportation will not be needed as you will be accommodated by the bottom station of the ski lift or provided with local transfers from the OC.

ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

Accommodation is offered on the first came first serverd basis in 6x-apartments/cottages (3 double rooms per apartment) located by the bottom station of the ski lift. Further accommodation possibilities include a lake resort hotel 40 km away from the ski area (accessible with the LOC transfer).

FIS rules and rates apply (CHF 50 for HB). Additionally OC offers an upgrade to full board accommodation for extra 15 Swiss Francs per person per day. Lunch for all teams will be organized in a restaurant by the bottom station of the ski lift 200 m away from the finish area. Payments will be accepted on the arrival day from team captains.

Official Arrival Day is February 21; official Departure Day is February 26.

Same conditions cannot be guaranteed outside of these dates (earlier arrivals or later departures).

One single room per team will be provided. An odd number resulting in a 2nd single room will be charged at the equivalent of 100 Swiss Francs. Additional single rooms requests are subject to availability at market rates.

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

Cancellations after February 14 and no-shows will be charged individually by the hotel.

Please note: all payments on site are to be made in local currency (Russian rubles) in cash or by bank card upon arrival. Currency exchange services will be available at the airport of arrival (Moscow) and in the city of Miass. ATM is available on site.

RADIO COMMUNICATION

If your team is planning to use radios during the competition week, you need to comply with the Russian radio communication regulations which may include (but not be limited to) applying for a radio license, reprogramming own radios or using rented equipment instead. We would like to make our participants' stay in Sunny Valley as convenient as possible. Therefore, we kindly ask you to fill out the Radio Communication Questionnaire (see Annex 3) and e-mail it to race@rsaski.ru as soon as possible.

Please note, that this is *not* a license application form yet. This is an extra form, completing which you help us to find the best way to assist you with the organization of radio communication during the competitions according to the applicable national regulations. After having received and processed the necessary data we will advise you on further actions.

INSURANCE/LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations, who attend and participate in the competitions, shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Freestyle Federation of Russia and Sunny Valley alpine resort shall not be responsible for any loss or injuries occurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person, in connection with the event.

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizers decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims during the competitions. All athletes must have previously signed "FIS Athletes Declaration" form, in order to be registered.

OTHER

Race Office Race office will be located at Sunny Valley resort, about 500 m

away from the finish area and about 700 m away from team accommodation. During the competitions shuttle busses will be running on the territory of the resort on a regular basis. Team registration and accreditation procedure will start on Tuesday,

February 21, from 14:00 am at the race office.

First Team Captains Meeting Tuesday, February 21 at 20:00 at the race office.

Russian Visa Application for AUDI FIS Ski Cross World Cup Sunny Valley Participants Step-by-Step Guide

The Organizer provides visa support for the participants of the event who need an invitation to apply for a visa. Below you will find our 'Visa Application Guide' created for your reference. Details may vary from country to country. Please, enquire about regulations which may be valid in your case.

Thanks to the consideration of the Consulate Department of the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) special regulations will be in force for the competition participants between January 10 and February 20, 2017: **one** team representative will be able to submit visa applications for **all** team members at **any** Russian consulate within EU and some other countries and request whenever possible **same day** visa procession.

If you would like to process your visa before the season, please, let us know so we could advise you further. Procession times before the special regulations come into force vary depending on your country of citizenship and working times of particular consulates.

In any case, visa support requests should be submitted to the OC before **February 5, 2017**. Timely procession after this date cannot be guaranteed.

Here is the description of the application process step-by-step:

Step 1 - Information

Check specific regulations applying to the citizens of your home country and to the applicants of the Russian consulate you will apply at. Contacts of Russian Embassies and Consulates are posted on the MFA website.

Please, note that after many years of experience the OC does **not** recommend using services of any visa or travel agencies due to highly possible delays. The only intermediates recommended are *Official Russian Visa Centers* working directly with Russian Embassies and Consulates. Their contacts and links to their webpages are <u>always posted on consulates websites</u>.

Step 2 - Invitation

To request a visa invitation (visa support), please, e-mail the OC race@rsaski.ru, receive the visa support request form, fill it out and send back together with passport type photos for every team member. Please, make sure names of files contain names of participants, for example «Surname Name.jpg»

Step 3 - Application

Prepare visa application package(s): fill out consulate application forms, collect necessary documents as stated on the consulate website, schedule an appointment if required, and pay the consular fee. Then submit the complete package(s) to the consulate.

Application package checklist:

Invitation – a letter you obtain and receive from the OC.















- Passport original, no copies, valid <u>at least until August 27, 2017</u>, containing <u>at least two</u> clean pages.
- Passport-size photograph recent, good quality check the consulate website for other requirements.
- **Visa application** as a rule is to be completed on-line and printed out see links on the consulate website.
- **Consulate-specific documents** like insurance, bank statements, etc. check the consulate website for specific regulations.

Insurance – if needed is a travel insurance valid on the territory of the Russian Federation covering sports-specific risks, medical treatment and transportation from abroad costs. Make sure that insurance company is approved by your consulate. A list of such companies is normally published on consulate websites.

Important

All difficulties in regard to the communication with Russian Consulates and Visa Centers are to be reported to the OC immediately.

EU and Non-EU citizens – different regulations apply, citizens of other countries within your teams may be required to complete different application forms and pay different visa fees. Some non-EU citizens may be allowed to enter Russia without a visa according to special agreements made between particular countries.

Once you receive your passport(s) from the consulate, please, check if all the data in the visa is correct and inform the OC by means of a phone call or an e-mail.
