ACCIDENT PROTOCOL	In case of accident on courses during the event, medical staff from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital
SCHEDULE	The organizing committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather or the decision of the competition jury.
PRIZEGIVING	Saturday 11.03 17.00 at Kungsberget Skilodge room "Fröjd". Sunday 12.03 right after the finals in the finish area.
DINNER	If you wish to dine in the hotel restaurant we recommend you to reserve a table in advance.
TO GET THERE	From Stockholm drive the E4 north to Gävle 1,5hrs. Then take the E16 to Sandviken 15min, in Sandviken follow the signs to Kungsberget 20min.
