[Toronto Ski Club's](#) (TSC) private clubhouse proudly sits at the base of the north end of Blue Mountain, Ontario's largest mountain village resort. TSC started in 1924 with a trailblazing membership that made it their mission to explore and ski as much downhill terrain that they could find, and who ultimately played a pivotal role in the establishment of skiing in Canada. Blue Mountain is nestled on the shores of Southern Georgian Bay and spans across the beautiful Niagara Escarpment. Blue Mountain offers 42 trails across 324 acres and offers complimentary shuttles across the resort to TSC.

The TSC clubhouse is just 10 minutes west of Collingwood and less than two hours from Toronto Pearson International Airport. The TSC Alpine NorAm will take place on Starting Gate with a vertical drop of 170m and a length of 565m.

NorAm PGS #2 on site registration will close at 3h00PM February 14th, 2017.
FIS Junior PGS on site registration will NOT be available.

International Athletes Notice

In order to confirm your registration, the Event Organizers need to receive a written confirmation from your National Snowboard Association confirming that you are in good standing, prior to your arrival at the event. Note: A valid FIS License is required to register.

Eligibility

Competitors must meet the following age limit in order to compete:
PSL | PGS 15 years+ old by December 31. 2016.

Competitors must also hold a valid FIS License. Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, SAIP insurance and Provincial or Territorial Snowboard Association Membership before registering through your Provincial or Territorial Association.
