The 2017 Toytoa Revolution Tour at Seven Springs Slopestyle competition will be FIS sanctioned and World Snowboarding Tour (WST) National Level events as well as a World Rookie Tour Qualifier.

World Rookie Tour

The Seven Springs Revolution Tour is part of the World Rookie Fest and the top winners for Slopestyle will qualify into the Volkl World Rookie Tour Finals in Kapran, Austria. For more information on the WRT click here.

Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Snowboard Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the final team entries with a FIS Entry Form (ICR Art. 217) to Larkin Jameson at Ijameson@ussa.org no later than 14 days prior to the first day of official training (rule 2002.2). Entry deadline **February 20, 2017**

Team Quotas

Slopestyle:

Each Nation will receive 1 spot per gender per discipline with any remaining spots (up to 25 counting both genders) given to competitors according to their standing on the current points list (FIS or WSPL points list – whichever is higher). Gender allocation of any remaining spots will be based on a ratio of 60% for men and 40% for ladies. All remaining spots, after the above gender allocation formula, not taken by one gender can be transferred to the other gender. Maximum quota (of International spots) per Nation is 5 regardless of rank.
