### THE RESORT

Mont Tremblant Ski Resort (known as Tremblant) is a year-round resort in the Laurentian Mountains of Quebec, Canada, about 130km (80ml) northwest of Montreal. It is best known as a ski destination, but also features Lake Tremblant suitable for swimming and two golf courses in the summer months. The name of the Mountain, Mont Tremblant, was derived from the local Algonwuin natives, who called in the "trembling mountain".

The summit is at an elevation of 875 metres (2,871 ft), which makes it on of the tallest peaks in the Laurentians.

The mountain and resort are part of the Mont Tremblant National Park and are both located near the village of Mont Tremblant.

### International Athletes Notice

In order to confirm your registration, the Event Organizers need to receive a written confirmation from your National Snowboard Association confirming that you are in good standing, prior to your arrival at the event. The confirmation letter can be submitted by email to: <u>evenements@quebecsnowboard.ca</u>

*Note:* A valid FIS License is required to register. Canadian athletes can purchase Provincial membership, SAIP insurance and FIS under Member Services <u>HERE</u>

### Eligibility

Competitors must meet the following age limit in order to compete:

SBX 15 years+ (born before December 31, 1999)

Competitors must also hold a valid FIS License. Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, SAIP insurance and Provincial or Territorial Snowboard Association Membership before registering through your Provincial or Territorial Association.

# **REFUND POLICY**

Event Registration Fee refunds require the approval Quebec Snowboard Association Executive Director.

Request for refund must be submitted by email to: evenements@quebecsnowboard.ca

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event must be confirmed with doctor's note.
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of Quebec Snowboard Associations Executive Director

Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque. Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit.

Lift Tickets are not refundable.

**Deposit Policies** 

- Reservations are made on an individual basis and will be made according to availability
