**FIS SBX At Martock**

**Feb 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017**



## Location and venue

Ski Martock is located in Windsor, Nova Scotia. 50 min from the Halifax International Airport and one hour from downtown Halifax. Martock has seven trails including a terrain park, half pipe, riglet park, beginner bowl, 1 quad chairlift, two T-bar lifts and a Magic Carpet, all with lighting for night snowboarding. Martock hosted all the snowboard events for the 2015 Canada Winter Games in Halifax.

## Competition's

February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017 – Snowboard Cross Training

February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2017 – Snowboard Cross Competition #1

February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017 – Snowboard Cross Competition #2

Course is located just above halfway on Expressway. Athletes are instructed to use the T-bar lift to halfway and walk up the right side of the course, closest to the trees.

## Categories

Male: FIS (15+) | U15 (13-14)

Female: FIS (15+) | U15 (13-14)

Age as of December 31, 2016

## Eligibility

FIS competitors must be 15 years + (born before December 31, 2001). Competitors must also hold a valid FIS License and SAIP insurance.

U15 athletes must have a Snowboard NS membership (or other provincial membership)

Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, SAIP insurance and Provincial Membership before registering at Canada Snowboard – Member Services.

Athletes are strongly encouraged to register on-line (prior to February 17, 2017) to benefit from the online and pre-registration rates; and it saves time and secures a competition spot for you. Note: A valid FIS License is required to register.

Cost \$50.00 per event online registration

On-Site registration at the Event Office is based on availability and will only be open Feb 17 8am-4pm.

Cost \$60.00 per event on-site registration

International Athletes To confirm your registration, the Event Organizers need to receive written confirmation from your National Snowboard Association that you are in good standing, prior to your arrival at the event. ## Sanction and Rules

The competitions are sanctioned by the FIS, Canada~Snowboard and Snowboard NS. Certified helmets are mandatory for all training and competitions (FIS ICR Rule 2010.6), for both competitors and coaches (Nova Scotia Law) Competitions are run in accordance with the FIS rules. Every athlete MUST be represented by a Team Captain (Coach) at the TC meeting.

## Sign in and waivers

Athlete and Coach Sign In - all athletes and coaches must sign waivers. Training bibs will be distributed at Registration

## Lift Tickets

Athletes will be able to purchase lift tickets as a cost of \$20 per day. You will purchase your lift ticket from the registration.

Coaches who register in advance will receive free lift tickets.
