In order to confirm your registration, the Event Organizers need to receive a written confirmation from your National Snowboard Association confirming that you are in good standing, prior to your arrival at the event. *Note: A valid FIS License is required to register.*

### Eligibility

Competitors must meet the following age limit in order to compete:

SBX                                    15 years+ by December 31, 2016

Competitors must also hold a valid FIS License. Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, SAIP insurance and Provincial or Territorial Snowboard Association Membership before registering through your Provincial or Territorial Association.
