TEAM INVITATION

On behalf of the Austrian Ski Federation, the Stubai valley and the Stubai Glacier ski resort, we are pleased to invite all teams to attend the FIS Freeski World Cup Stubai. The event will be held in accordance with the International Ski Federation (FIS) rules for competitions & World Cup rules and is sanctioned as an AFP platinum contest.

The event starts on Thursday, November 23, with the first official practice. An unofficial training is scheduled on November 22. Friday, November 24, and Saturday, November 25 are the qualification days. Finals take place on Sunday, November 26, 2017.

There is no reserve day in case of bad weather.

REGISTRATION

Entries will only be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules for slopestyle events. Entries are open now and must be submitted to the OC using the FIS online registration system within the mentioned deadlines. Please make sure that all athletes have a valid FIS license. The World Cup rules are available on the FIS website.

Pre entry deadline October 10, 2017.

Final entry deadline November 15, 2017.

The Stubai valley is located roughly 15 km from the Tyrolean provincial capital, Innsbruck. The valley extends more than 35 kilometers deep into the mountainscape of the Stubai Alps, where the glacier ski resort „Stubaier Gletscher“ is located. The Stubai Glacier is home to one of Europe's finest terrain parks, the “Stubai Zoo”, which has earned an excellent reputation within the international freestyle scene.

ACCOMODATION

We are offering team accommodation at CHF 80,- per day per person according to the FIS World Cup rules. Please forward us your team accommodation request with the provisional entries (ladies/men/officials) before October the 10th, 2017. Please note that accommodation at the FIS rate is available for the dates of the program only:

Arrival: Tuesday, November 21 - Departure: Monday, November 27
 Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS rate.

PARKING & TRAFFIC

Parking at the bottom station of the 3S Eisgrat cable-car is free of charge. There will be a dedicated parking area close to the entrance for athletes and officials only. The required parking permit will be handed out at the registration. Please be aware of traffic jams in the mornings on the road from Neustift to the lift station (20 km distance). Without traffic jam it takes around 30 minutes to get from Neustift to the bottom station. From there to the venue it's another 30 minutes.

ACCREDITATION

Registration and accreditation will be held at the event office - **Hotel Happy Stubai**, on Nov. 21. Please see the schedule for registration times. All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the registration area for check-in before proceeding to the competition venue.

If you are planning to bring a media team with you or know of someone wishing to cover the event, please note that they must be accredited by the Stubai Freeski World Cup media office. This applies whether they are editorial media or filming for promotional purposes.

ENTRY FEES & LIFT TICKETS

An administrative fee will be charged for each World Cup competitor.

This fee will be refundable should the event be cancelled.

All fees will be collected upon check-in.

The administrative fee is CHF 120,- (as per FIS rules) per competitor.

Lift passes will be provided to all competitors and team officials for official training and competition days and will be distributed at the first team captains' meeting. The number of free lift tickets given out to team officials will be relative to the team's size (as per FIS World Cup rules).



Please note that we have to collect € 2,- per lift ticket as a key card deposit (cash only). For all other payments we accept debit and credit cards as well as cash.

BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all scheduled official trainings, competition and at the award ceremony. Training and competition bibs will also be allocated at the team captains meetings. A deposit of € 20,- per bib will be required in cash at the first team captains' meeting.

ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All competitors must have their own medical insurance. The organizing committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers, the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and members of National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The organizing committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers, the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation shall not be responsible



for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing and staging of the event.

FIRST TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING

The first team captains' meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 22 at 7:00pm CET, at the official event hotel:
Hotel Happy Stubai, Wiesenweg 16, 6167 Neustift im Stubaital.

TRAINING

An unofficial training is scheduled on November 22. The competition Set up will be exclusively available for competing athletes. Dedicated staff like section chiefs, doctor, etc. won't be present. Accommodation and meals will be provided from Tuesday onwards and lift tickets will be provided from Wednesday onwards. At the resort, the normal mountain patrol service (highly qualified) will be available on call, as for all other slopes. An official training is scheduled on November 23 and November 24. Additional training will take place before each heat during competition, on November 25 and 26.

SANCTIONING

FIS Freeski World Cup Stubai is a co-sanctioned event:
FIS Freeski World Cup and AFP Platinum level.
Athletes must have a valid FIS license to compete, and will only receive points in the AFP ranking system if they hold a current AFP membership.

AWARD CEREMONY – PRIZE MONEY

Flower and medal ceremonies will take place on the mountain immediately after the competitions' final. Podium placing athletes are obliged to attend these ceremonies and should be available for media interviews and athlete signings immediately after the awards.

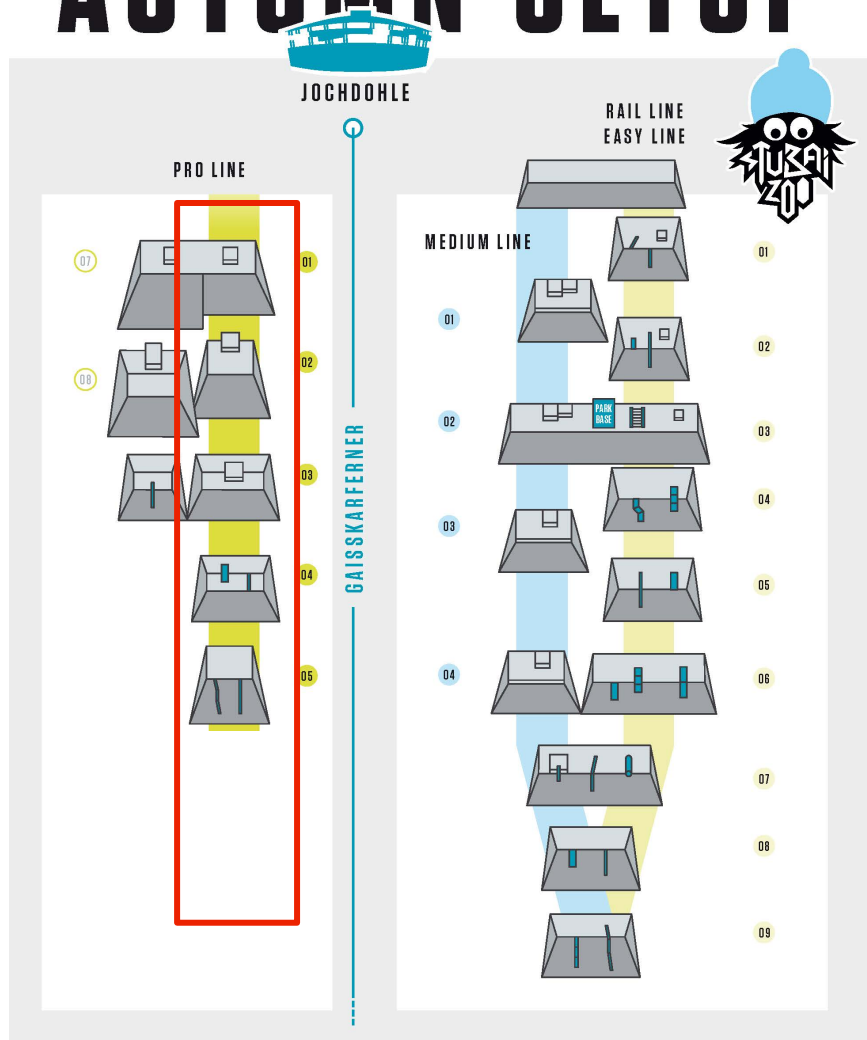

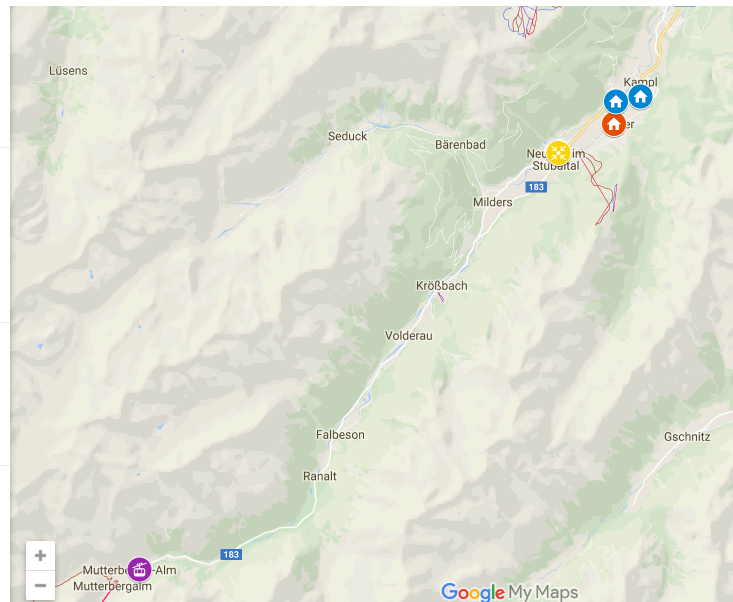


LOCATION MAP
